**Obama’s “Fake War” against the Islamic State (ISIS).
The Islamic State is being protected by the US and its Allies.**

Since August 2014, the US Air Force with the support of a coalition of 19 countries has relentlessly waged an intensified air campaign against Syria and Iraq allegedly targeting the Islamic State brigades.

According to Defense News, over 16,000 airstrikes were carried out from August 2014 to mid January 2015. Sixty percent of the air strikes were conducted by the US Air Force using advanced jet fighter and bombing capabilities (Aaron Mehta, “A-10 Performing 11 Percent of Anti-ISIS Sorties”. Defense News, January 19, 2015.)

The airstrikes have been casually described by the media as part of a “soft” counter-terrorism operation, rather than an act of all out war directed against Syria and Iraq.

Question for Our Readers

Why has the US Air Force not been able to wipe out the Islamic State which at the outset was largely equipped with conventional small arms not to mention state of the art Toyota pickup trucks? From the very outset, this air campaign has NOT been directed against ISIS. The evidence confirms that the Islamic State is not the target. Quite the opposite. The air raids are intended to destroy the economic infrastructure of Iraq and Syria.

We call on our readers to carefully reflect on the following image, which describes the Islamic State convoy of pickup trucks entering Iraq and crossing a 200 km span of open desert which separates the two countries.

This convoy entered Iraq June 2014. What would have been required from a military standpoint to wipe out an ISIS convoy with no effective anti-aircraft capabilities?

Without an understanding of military issues, common sense prevails.



If they had wanted to eliminate the Islamic State brigades, they could have “carpet” bombed their convoys of Toyota pickup trucks when they crossed the desert from Syria into Iraq in June. A rapid and expedient surgical operation would have decimated the Islamic State convoys in a matter of hours.

Instead what we have witnessed is an ongoing drawn out six months of relentless air raids and bombings, and the terrorist enemy is apparently still intact.

And we are led to believe that the Islamic State cannot be defeated by a powerful US led military coalition of 19 countries. The air campaign was not intended to decimate the Islamic State.



The counter-terrorism mandate is a fiction. America is the Number One "State Sponsor of Terrorism".

The Islamic State is not only protected by the US and its allies, it is trained and financed by US-NATO, with the support of Israel and Washington's Persian Gulf allies.

Iraqis find Saudi supplies, weapons destined for ISIS

If there still were any question of whether or not Saudi Arabia has been quietly supporting ISIS, Iraqi security forces who raided ISIS strongholds in Saddam Hussein's hometown of Tikrit have provided further evidence.

In their effort to retake Tikrit, the Iraqis found in ISIS storage areas several tons of foodstuffs and dried fruit from Saudi Arabia along with weapons.

The discovery came as some 30,000 Iraqi troops and militias began a counter-offensive backed by airstrikes to take back Tikrit from ISIS fighters. Iraqi forces are attacking from three sides and now control the northern areas of the Albu Obaid village and west of Tikrit, which would be a stepping stone to retake the northern Iraqi city of Mosul.

The operation marks a major test for Iraqi forces. Last June, some 13,000 Iraqi military abandoned their weapons when only 2,000 ISIS fighters captured Mosul, a city of 1.5 million people.

In initially launching the attack, Iraqi security forces came across tons of "humanitarian" foodstuffs with Saudi labels saying: "Saudi Arabia Kingdom of Humanity, Emergency Relief Aid for the Needy."

The Iraqi forces are being joined by elements of the Kurdish Peshmerga, Sunni tribes, Iranian Revolutionary Guard Corps troops and Shiite militia, which includes the Iranian-backed Hezbollah.

Officially, Saudi Arabia and other ISIS supporters such as Turkey and Qatar deny their citizens help ISIS. Saudi Arabia and Qatar even point to laws they have passed to make it difficult for individuals to send aid to militants. However, enforcement of such laws and policies is questionable.

While ISIS doesn't get arms supplies directly from such supporting states as Saudi Arabia, Qatar or Turkey, they come from, "individuals working in the private sector of arms companies that are making these deals, so they are already in business of logistics and moving stuff around," Carafano said.

He said the weapons captured while taking Mosul has put ISIS "in good shape for a long time."

ISIS doesn't know how to use many of the modern U.S. weapons that it has acquired but US trained defectors would.

Separately, Hussein al-Ramahi, who heads the political commission of the Iranian-backed Hezbollah brigades, disclosed that his forces have discovered Saudi-supplied arms and ammunition in areas taken back from ISIS control that have been dropped to ISIS fighters from unidentified aircraft.

Also, ISIS has seized a significant number of U.S.-manufactured small



arms and rifles from the Iraqi military, including M16 assault rifles manufactured by Colt and FN Manufacturing of Belgium. The weapons had labels designating them as "Property of U.S. Govt."

When ISIS captured Mosul using only 2,000 fighters, it took hold of a significant amount of weaponry to arm itself like a conventional army. "You lost approximately three divisions worth of equipment and probably at least three depots in that area, according to Anthony Cordesman, a security analyst with the Washington-based Center for Strategic and International Studies.

ISIS also captured anti-aircraft weaponry when it overran a Syrian air force base last year. It can down aircraft flying at 16,000 feet. The weapons would be in addition to the various tanks ISIS has captured, including T-55s, T-62s, T-72s and BRDM-2 armored vehicles from Russia, which are Soviet-era weapons. ISIS also has captured MT-LB armored vehicles from Bulgaria, some 20 old Soviet BMP-1 infantry fighting vehicles, a fleet of U.S. Humvees, and countless rocket-propelled grenades and launchers, such as the RPG-7.

Syria: Collapse of US Backed Moderate Rebel Group transfers advanced heavy weapons to ISIS

The Hazm movement was seen as a cornerstone of the train-and-equip program Washington hopes will bring thousands of non-extremist fighters to bear against IS in Syria. But after suffering a devastating defeat at the hands of Al Qaeda's Syrian affiliate at the weekend, Hazm appears to have disbanded, with many of its fighters reported to have joined an Islamist coalition.

"The collapse of... Hazm means that, in effect, there is no substantial and credible Western-backed 'moderate' opposition throughout most of Syria," intelligence consultancy The Soufan Group said in a brief.

Mainly present in Idlib and Aleppo provinces in northern Syria, the group, known in Arabic as Harakat Hazm, consisted of several thousand fighters and was last year cited by US Secretary of State John Kerry as likely to receive US arms and training.

Its creation was announced in January last year as a coalition of a dozen rebel groups from the Free Syrian Army that had taken up arms against President Bashar al-Assad. It was the first rebel group to receive US-made TOW anti-tank missiles from Western backers in April 2014. In recent months it had been coming under increasing pressure from jihadist fighters including from Syrian Al Qaeda affiliate the Al-Nusra Front, which had already dislodged Hazm from several areas.

On Saturday, Nusra launched a major assault on Hazm's main operations center - Base 46 in Aleppo province - which members of the group had seized from troops loyal to Assad in November 2012. "Nusra kept pushing with heavy artillery and shelling for four to five hours," said Louay Meqdad, head of the Research Center for Free Syrian Army Affairs and former spokesman for the FSA.

In one night alone, he said, 73 Hazm fighters were killed. Nusra overran the base and, according to the Syrian Observatory for Human Rights monitoring



group, seized as many as 80 of the TOW American produced anti-tank guided missiles, each with the capability to stop a heavily armoured tank in its tracks. Images circulated on social media showed Nusra fighters proudly brandishing their deadly new weapons.

The next day, a statement from Hazm announced it was disbanding. AFP could not independently confirm the statement's authenticity but several fighters from the movement said via social media that they would be joining the Shamiyah Front, a large coalition of Sunni Islamist groups in Aleppo province.

Washington downplayed the incident, with a US military official saying the United States was resolved to its effort with moderate rebels and aims to train about 5,000 Syrian fighters this year and roughly 15,000 over three years.

US Takes Back Seat as Iran Runs Op on Key ISIS Stronghold

The United States and its allies have received no request from Iraq to carry out air strikes in support of Baghdad government troops fighting to recapture the key stronghold of Tikrit, the Pentagon said Monday.

The Iraqi operation to take back Tikrit from Islamic State (ISIS) jihadists is the largest-scale offensive yet launched by Baghdad, and Shi'ite militia backed by neighboring Iran were playing a key role.

But the US-led coalition, which has conducted thousands of air strikes against the ISIS group to back up Iraqi and Kurdish forces on the ground, is not providing air power for the latest Iraqi offensive, officials said. "We're not providing air strikes in support of the operation around Tikrit," Pentagon spokesman Colonel Steven Warren told reporters.

It was unclear if Tehran's role may have been a factor in the US-led coalition's absence, given that the US is currently engaged in last minute negotiations over Iran's nuclear program. The assault on ISIS in Tikrit included Iraqi aircraft but it was unclear if Iranian planes were also involved.

Both Iraqi and Iranian media reported that Qassem Soleimani - commander of the Al-Quds Force cover operations unit of Iran's elite Revolutionary Guards - was in the area to help oversee operations.

Warren declined to say whether US surveillance aircraft were providing intelligence for the Tikrit operation. But a Pentagon official, speaking on condition of anonymity, said that American planes were assisting with intelligence and reconnaissance.

Warren stressed that Iraq was a sovereign country and it was up to the government in Baghdad to decide when it required military assistance from coalition warplanes. "We were aware of the operation before it started but I'm not going to get into the details of what degree of cooperation we conducted before this," he said. "We're tracking it closely."

Asked about Iran's activities, he said: "We're aware that there is great Iranian interest in Iraq's fight against ISIL," using another acronym by which the group is known. But he said he would not discuss the details of Iran's involvement in the conflict.
