Abbas Kamal, a senior Egyptian intelligence official, visited Tel Aviv yesterday and is slated to meet with Palestinian Authority President Mahmoud Abbas to discuss the situation in the Gaza Strip on Thursday, London-based Al-Hayat newspaper reported.

Kamal and the PA president will meet to discuss both the issue of Palestinian reconciliation between Hamas and Fatah as well as the future of Gaza.

According to the report, Kamal met with Israeli officials on Wednesday and spoke about a possible prisoner

exchange deal and updated them on the results of the recent talks between Hamas and Fatah in Egypt. Meanwhile, representatives of the Popular Front and the Democratic Front for the Liberation of Palestine are expected to arrive in Cairo Thursday morning and join the series of meetings.

These meetings in Israel follow previous clandestine meetings with Egypt. Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu met secretly in Cairo in May with Egyptian President Abdel Fattah al-Sisi to discuss ways to end the violence in Gaza.

According to a Channel 10 report, Netanyahu traveled to Cairo with a small number of advisers and security guards on May 22, when he joined Sisi in the Iftar feast breaking the Ramadan fast. It occurred just a week after the US moved its embassy to Jerusalem, and violence along the Gaza border peaked when 62 Palestinians were killed in riot.

According to the report, Sisi said that the solution to the crisis in Gaza "runs through" a return of the Palestinian Authority to Gaza, and its taking responsibility for the Strip – even if all of PA President Mahmoud Abbas' conditions for returning to Gaza were not met. The report said Sisi's message was that Israel, the Arab world, and the international community needed to press Abbas to return to Gaza, even though he is opposed.

Netanyahu and Sisi last met publicly on the sidelines of the UN General Assembly meeting in New York last



September. They have reportedly held other clandestine meetings over the years, as security and intelligence ties between the two countries are believed to be as close as they have ever been.

The relative quiet of the last few days led Israel to open the Kerem Shalom on Wednesday to trucks bringing supplies into Gaza. That crossing has been largely closed since mid-July, as a response to the wave of incendiary balloons and kites that set alight thousands of dunams around the Gaza Strip.

Following the security cabinet meeting on Wednesday – the fourth meeting held on Gaza over the last 10 days – one diplomatic official said there would not be a "true arrangement" with Hamas without the return to Israel of the bodies of the two IDF soldiers and the two Israeli citizens being held in the Strip. "The current quiet is a result of the aggressive actions of the IDF, which will continue as needed," the official said.

PM NETANYAHU PRESENTS "2030 SECURITY CONCEPT" TO THE CABINET

Communicated by the Prime Minister's Media Adviser from IMRA, August 16, 2018 Wed Aug 15th, Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu, presented to the Cabinet. the "2030 Security Concept", which has been formulated over the past two years

Today's was the first of a series of discussions on the issue. The Prime Minister presented the anticipated threats for the coming decade, the building of the necessary force and the principles for operation of the force.

The full document is classified and will soon be presented in full by the Prime Minister to the Knesset Subcommittee on Intelligence Affairs and Secret Services, the IDF General Staff Forum, the Mossad and the ISA. The non-classified part of the document pertains to the budgetary implications which will soon be submitted for Cabinet approval.

Due to the anticipated threats over the coming decade:

- 1. The Prime Minister intends to increase the security budget by 0.2-0.3% of GNP as the IDF becomes more efficient:
- 2. The budgetary increase is designed for expenditure on all security bodies (IDF, ISA, Mossad and others), which currently stands at approximately 6% of GNP.
- 3. The goal is average annual growth of 3-4% and average expenditure of approximately 6% of GNP for all security needs.
- 4. When GNP reaches \$0.5 trillion, the required rate for overall expenditure on security will be reexamined.

The budgetary supplement will be allocated to a series of issues including:

- Strengthening offensive capabilities
- Major power-level cyber capabilities
- Upgrading anti-missile defence
- Continued protective measures on the home front
- The completion of security fences.

Prime Minister Netanyahu:

"Due to our small area, the population concentration and the numerous threats around us, Israel will always have security needs that are much greater than any other state of similar size. Today the Israeli economy is strong enough to allow for this supplement. In any case the increase will be enacted while maintaining a responsible budgetary framework.

In the last 20 years we have cultivated a free economy in order to serve national needs, especially security. Against the accumulated threats we are at a turning point. Today we are called upon to invest more in security in order to defend our achievements and ensure continued economic growth.

The combination of our security and economic strengths will increase Israel's status as an asset in the eyes of other countries and thereby increase our diplomatic strength."

IAI to Provide Barak-8 Missile Defense System for Navy's new warships

The ships will protect strategic maritime assets.

Israel Aerospace Industries (IAI) will provide advanced defense systems to Israel Navy's new Sa'ar-6 corvettes to protect strategic maritime assets, the defense giant announced on Tuesday.

The contract was led by the navy, the Directorate of Defense Research and Development (DDR&D) and the procurement administration in Israel's Defence Ministry.

The Barak- 8 system was chosen after it was demonstrated to meet the operational requirements and future challenges faced by Israel's navy.

The systems will be used to protect Israel's exclusive economic zone and strategic facilities that are faced with diversified threats in the marine arena.

Two Israeli Universities in World's Top 100 Institutions

The prestigious Shanghai Ranking of world universities on Tuesday listed two Israeli academic institutions in the world's top 100, marking an impressive rise since last year.

The Haifa-based Technion — Israel Institute of Technology — was listed as Israel's premier university for the third year in a row in the Shanghai Ranking Consultancy's Academic Ranking of World Universities 2018. It ranked 77th, a rise of 16 places from its 93rd placing in last year's list.

Israel's first university – The Hebrew University of Jerusalem – celebrating 100 years since the laying of its cornerstone, was ranked 95th. It marked the university's return to the top-100, just a year after its fifteen-year presence in such elite company had come to an end.

"The trend of improvement compared to last year's Shanghai ranking is evidence of hard work and uncompromising striving for excellency," commented Hebrew University President Prof. Asher Cohen.

"We are proud that again, the Hebrew

University is recognized as one of the world's 100 leading universities," he said, adding that the competition was getting harder every year due to "significant investment" by East Asian countries in academic institutions.

The Technion's president, Prof. Peretz Lavie, commented that, "We constantly measure ourselves and improve regardless of international rankings, but of course a high place in the Shanghai ranking is an exciting stamp of international recognition of the Technion's excellence," he added.

There was no change in the rankings of Israel's other universities. The Weitzmann Institute of Technology was included in the group of institutions ranked 101-150, the Tel Aviv University was in the group ranked 151-200, and both the Bar-Ilan University and Ben-Gurion University of the Negev remained in the group ranked 401-500.

The top-10 rankings remained the same as the 2017 edition of the list, with two Ivy League schools – Harvard and Stanford – taking the top two spots respectively, and the UK's University of Cambridge placing third.
