A Letter From The Principal Yoel Russu

This September is a significant month in the life of our school. **For the first time in the history of ‘Makor HaTikvah,’ and perhaps in the history of Israel, we opened the gates of our Messianic school as a school certified and recognized by the State of Israel.**

We are grateful for the perseverance, prayers and financial support. Above all we thank our gracious Lord for answered prayers and for making what often seemed impossible, a reality. Thank you, God!

In September, nine new families joined our school. Some of them are new immigrants coming from different countries. We are excited to see new believers coming to school and having the opportunity to help them build their homes in the Land of Israel.

September has many holidays (Holy Days). Days appointed by God to remind us of both historical and prophetic times. The Feast of Trumpets, now called Rosh HaShana (Jewish New Year); Yom Kippur (Day of Atonement); and Sukkot (Feast of Tabernacles).

During the Feast of Trumpets, you can hear blasts of a ram’s horn, shofar or trumpet everywhere. It resembles the sound of weeping, pleading before God; reminding us that the Lord hears our cries. The trumpet sound also reminds us the prophesied return of our King.

Yom Kippur is a day of accountability, a day to forgive and be forgiven. We remember Yeshua Jesus as the complete atonement and sacrifice that was given for us to cover all our sins. The people of Israel will be saved through Him, once and forever (Romans 11:26). Sukkot commemorates the 40 years Israelites wandered in the dessert and dwelt in temporary shelters (sukkot). The prophecy about the day of the Lord in Zechariah 14:16 speaks of “all nations going up to Jerusalem year after year to worship the King, the Lord Almighty, and to celebrate the Festival of Tabernacles.”

These are the holidays that proclaim the coming of our Messiah and remind us that we must be ready to meet Him at any moment. Therefore, it is very important for us, at Makor HaTikvah School, to maintain the atmosphere among the staff and students, where He finds us ready when He returns. We aim to prepare a new generation of faithful believers, full of fruits of the Holy Spirit. Happy Holy Days to the entire family of “Makor HaTikvah” and to all our supporters.



Palestine files complaint over U.S. Embassy in Jerusalem in World Court

The Palestinian suit requests the court “to order the United States of America to withdraw (its) diplomatic mission from the Holy City of Jerusalem.”

AMSTERDAM - The International Court of Justice on Friday said it has received a complaint from the "State of Palestine" against the United States, arguing that the US government's placement of its Israeli embassy in Jerusalem violates an international treaty and it should be removed.

The ICJ, known as the World Court, said in a statement "Palestine" argues the 1961 Vienna Convention of Diplomatic Relations requires a country to locate its embassy on the territory of a host state. While Israel controls Jerusalem militarily, its ownership is disputed.

In December, US President Donald Trump ordered the American embassy in Israel relocated from Tel Aviv to Jerusalem, and the new embassy opened in May.

The Palestinian suit requests the court “to order the United States of America to withdraw (its) diplomatic mission from the Holy City of Jerusalem.”

The ICJ is the United Nations' venue for resolving disputes between nations. The "State of Palestine" was recognized by the UN General Assembly in 2012 as a non-member observer state, though its statehood is not recognized by either Israel or the United States.

U.S. withdraws from international accords, says U.N. world court 'politicized'

The Trump administration on Wednesday pulled out of two international agreements after Iran and the Palestinians complained to the International Court of Justice about U.S. policies, the latest withdrawal by Washington from multilateral accords.

The U.S. national security adviser John Bolton slammed the highest United Nations tribunal as “politicized and ineffective” as he announced that the United States would review all international agreements that could expose it to binding decisions by the ICJ.

Earlier on Wednesday the ICJ handed a victory to Tehran, ordering the United States to ensure that sanctions against Iran, due to be tightened next month, do not affect humanitarian aid or civil aviation safety.

Tehran had argued that the U.S.

sanctions imposed since May by the Trump administration violated the terms their 1955 Treaty of Amity. Washington responded by pulling out of the treaty, a little-known agreement that was signed long before Iran's 1979 Islamic Revolution that turned the two countries into arch enemies.

The ICJ, based in The Hague, in the Netherlands, is the United Nations' venue for resolving disputes between nations.

Bolton, citing what he called "Iran's abuse of the ICJ," said the United States would also withdraw from the "optional protocol" under the 1961 Vienna Convention of Diplomatic Relations.

The Vienna Convention is an international treaty setting out

diplomatic relations between states. It is often cited as a means to provide diplomatic immunity.

Earlier, Secretary of State Mike Pompeo said the United States should have pulled out of the treaty of amity with Iran decades ago and said the ICJ it had no jurisdiction of sanctions that he said were essential to U.S. security interests.

The United States has adopted a hardline policy against Tehran, withdrawing from the 2015 nuclear deal and reimposing sanctions.

"Today marked a useful point, with the decision that was made this morning from the ICJ, this marked a useful point for us to demonstrate the absolute absurdity of the Treaty of Amity between the United States and the Islamic Republic of Iran," Pompeo said.

"This really has less to do with Iran and the Palestinians than with the continued consistent policy of the United States to reject the jurisdiction of the International Court of Justice, which we think is politicized and ineffective," Bolton said.

"I'd like to stress," he added, "the United States remains a party to the underlying Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations and we expect all other parties to abide by their international obligations under the convention."

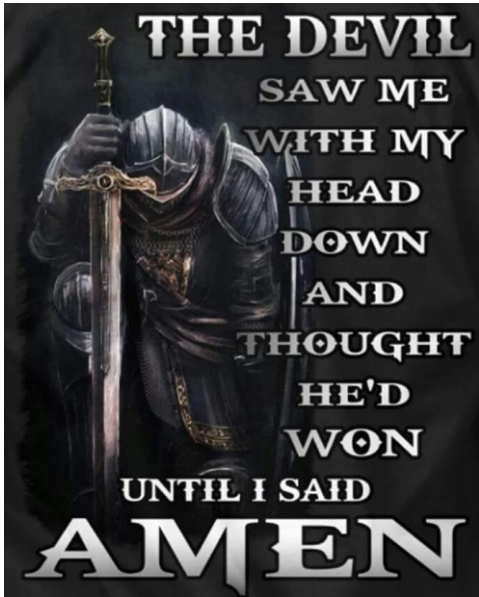
