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10 Major Deceptions that Orthodox Rabbinical Judaism has brought into Judaism

Orthodox rabbinical Judaism is in great deception having left God's biblical Words found in the Torah and the Tanakh, and focused its main attention on a non biblical oral Torah, created by man, by the rabbis, and not created by God. **This great idolatry** has spread throughout the nation of Israel and also to the Jews throughout the world, causing **Israel's Greatest Sin**, that of denying that their own God, the God of Israel became their Messiah and Savior and Lord. This Truth definitely needs to be exposed and challenged by the Jewish people of Israel, but especially by Yeshua's Israeli Messianic believers.

Here is a list of **10 major deceptions that Orthodox Rabbinical Judaism has brought into Judaism** over the centuries.

1) God gave Moses the divine written Words of the Torah which Moses wrote down at Mount Sinai. However **God never gave Moses a divine oral Torah**, which Rabbinical Judaism has taught now for almost 1800 years. This is a very great deception which Rabbinical Judaism has brought into Judaism, saying that God also gave Moses a divine oral Torah.

Around late 200 A.D., Rabbi Judah Hanasi wrote down this collection of the

rabbinical writings of their oral Torah into books known as the Talmud and the Mishna.

However there are **12 specific Scriptures** written by Moses in the Torah where **Moses explicitly forbids anyone from using any other words than God's written Words.**

And **this Truth is also found in 8 other Scripture references from the writings of the prophets.** It would have been a lot more honest for Orthodox Rabbinical Judaism to have never stated that their oral Torah came from God to Moses at Mount Sinai. That their writings were from rabbis, and scribes, and other bible teachers, and also from the traditions of men handed down through the centuries.

20 Scripture references prove that the Orthodox Rabbinical oral Torah was never given from God.

Exodus 24:3, 4; 34:27; Deuteronomy 4:2; 8:2, 3; 12:26-32; 28:1, 2, 15; 28: 58-61; 30:8-20; 31:10-13; 32:43-47.

Joshua 1:1, 2, 8; 8:34, 35; 23:6; Proverbs 30:6; Isaiah 59:21; 1st Chronicles 15:13-15; 2nd Kings 22:3, 8-13; 2nd Kings 23:11-3; Nehemiah 8:1-10.

2) Many of the 10 Commandments of God have been violated, ...by Rabbinical Judaism!

... The Rabbinical Jews put their major emphasis on their oral Rabbinical writings of men from Talmud, and Mishna, and Gemara, rather than on God's holy written Words. They defend themselves by saying that their oral Torah teachings were given by God to Moses. Since this is not true, then what they are teaching is idolatry. ...

3) The oral Torah has contributed to Israel's Greatest Sin, that of the



Jewish people of Israel and throughout the world **denying that Yeshua is their Messiah and Savior and Lord, the Holy One of Israel.** And yet Yeshua is prophesied in over 225 Scriptures in the Hebrew Holy Scriptures of the Torah and the Tanakh.

4) In our modern day Hebrew Jewish calendar all the names of the months have been taken from Babylonian names of their months, which was done by the Rabbinical Jews hundreds of years after the Jewish people had returned from exile. God had specifically told the Jewish people to only number each of their months, i.e. first month, second month, etc ... God never told Israel to give names to the different months of the year. One such example of this naming of the months is that the 7th biblical month in the bible was later called Tishri. That is the Babylonian name given for their 7th month. And also that is the name of the month for the Babylonian New Years. ...

In the book of Nehemiah 8:1-10, when the Jewish people returned from exile in Babylon, the seventh month was still just called the 7th month in Scripture (with no name given for that month). And the first day of that 7th month was still publically kept as God's holy day, celebrating it as the Fifth Feast of the LORD, Zichron Teruah, according to Leviticus 23:23, 24. **For rabbinical oral Torah deceptions had not yet begun** of naming that 7th month Tishri, and re-naming the 5th Feast of the LORD to Rosh HaShanah, Head of the Year, or Israel's New Years.

All the Israeli Jewish leaders were present there on that special Feast day ... Nehemiah 8:4 So Ezra the scribe stood on a platform of wood which they had made for the purpose; 8:5 And Ezra

opened the Book in the sight of all the people, for he was standing above all the people; and when he opened it, all the people stood up. 8:6 And Ezra blessed the LORD, the great God. Then all the people answered, "Amen, Amen!" while lifting up their hands. And they bowed their heads and worshiped the LORD with their faces to the ground. 8:7 And Yeshua (who was the high priest)... and the Levites helped the people to understand the Torah; 8:8 So they read distinctly from the Book, in the Torah of God; 8:9 And Nehemiah, who was the governor, Ezra the priest and scribe, and the Levites who taught the people said to all the people, "**This day is holy to the LORD your God (Leviticus 23:24)**; do not mourn nor weep." For all the people wept, when they heard the Words of the Torah. 8:10 Then he said to them, "Go your way, eat the fat, drink the sweet, and send portions to those for whom nothing is prepared; **for this day is holy to our Lord. Do not sorrow, for the Joy of the LORD is your strength!**" Clearly no oral Torah was in use then!

5) Israeli Jewish Biblical New Years was always kept in the spring of each year. God through Moses had specifically told Israel in Exodus 12:2, that Israel's New Years was to be in the spring on the first day of their first month of Passover.

Now the LORD spoke to Moses and Aaron in the land of Egypt, saying, "This month shall be your beginning of months, it shall be the first month of the year to you." And then the Passover - unleavened bread seven day Feast of the LORD was to begin the 14th day of that first month. That first biblical Feast of the LORD of Leviticus 23 was to last for seven days.

Rabbinical Judaism has changed God's Word, making **the Israeli New**

Years to be on the first day of the 7th month, which is the LORD's Fifth biblical Feast, found in Leviticus 23. And called this Feast by a new name, Rosh HaShanah, (Head of the Year), which is such a major deception to Judaism by changing the Word of God.

This Fifth Biblical Feast of the LORD was first called by God Zichron Teruah, in Leviticus 23:24, (in commemoration of the Trumpet blast by God from the top of Mount Sinai, in Exodus 19). It was later called Yom Teruah, day of the Trumpet, in Numbers 29:1. God never re-named this Feast day to Rosh Ha Shanah, the Head of the Year, or Jewish New Years.

By bringing this great deception into Judaism, the hidden meaning behind the LORD's 5th biblical Feast of Zichron Teruah, of the 7 Feasts of the LORD in Leviticus 23, has long stayed a mystery.

For this 5th Feast of the LORD is really the Marriage Feast of the Lamb. For this Feast is **Yeshua's Wedding with His Bride in Heaven**, which will take place very soon.

6) The Feast called Chanukkah which began around 165 B.C., is regularly celebrated each winter by most Jewish people. We can even see this feast being celebrated in Jerusalem during the days of Yeshua. See John 10:22

But the untaught truth about the Feast of Chanukkah is what the Maccabees, also an Aaronic priest family, really did at that time. They kicked out God's specifically appointed Zadokite high priest and all the Zadokite priests from the Jerusalem Temple. This true information about the Maccabees is still not publically being taught. The Maccabee family then took over all the Jerusalem Temple priestly functions, totally corrupting all the Jerusalem Temple priesthood

sacrifices, (from 165 B.C. until the Temple was destroyed by the Romans in 70 A.D) in violation to the Word of God that was specifically given only to the Zadokite high priest family. See God's Word given to the Zadokite high priests in Ezekiel 43:18, 19 and again in Ezekiel 44:15, 16, 23, 24.

Why is all this so important? Because it is also a major key in the mystery of the birth of Yeshua. For it is Yeshua's own priestly family from birth through His mother, the virgin Miriam, who was from the two families of her parents, that of king David's family and also high priest Zadok's family.

7) Around 700 - 1000 C.E. (A.D.) a group of religious Jews called the Masoretes got together and added vowels to the Hebrew letters to the Words of God in the original Hebrew Bible text, forming **Masoretic Bible Text** from the 24 books of the Torah and the Tanakh.

They also changed the meaning of some words in the biblical Scripture passages of the Torah and the Tanakh, especially passages about our promised Messiah. The Masoretic Bible Text is what is used today in all of Orthodox Rabbinic Judaism. The original Masoretic text has never been found.

Here are some examples of these biblical text changes:

Isaiah 53:11 ... My Righteous Servant shall justify many; Masoretic text: ... My servant, who by his knowledge did justify the Righteous One to the many;

Zechariah 12:10 They shall look upon Me whom they have pierced; Masoretic text: ... they will look to Me because they have thrust him through;

Psalms 22:16 ... they pierced My hands and feet; Masoretic text: (22:17) ...

they are at my hands and my feet;

Yeshua is not only the Lion of the tribe of Judah, because Miriam's father's family is from king David of the tribe of Judah. But what is rarely being taught is that Yeshua thru Miriam's mother's family is also the fulfillment of the high priest family of Zadok, from high priest Aaron. This can be proven in Luke 1:36, 6, and also in many other Messianic prophesies about the Branch, Tzemach, the Messiah, coming from the family of high priest Yehoshua of high priest Zadok of Aaron. See Jeremiah 33:17, 18, 24; Zechariah 3:1, 8; Zechariah 6:11-13; also Ezekiel 43:18, 19; and Ezekiel 44:15, 16. For Yeshua's Blood Sacrifice of His sinless flesh was honored by God because Yeshua was also born from Yehoshua's high priest family, from Zadok of Aaron.

8) **Keeping Kosher** [*no dairy with meat*] **was not something given to Israel by God. For the LORD Himself ate meat and milk together with butter**, which Abraham served Him and the two messengers which came with the LORD. God did not keep kosher. Keeping kosher is not from God. See Genesis 18:5-8: Genesis 18:1 Then **the LORD** (יהוה) appeared to him by the terebinth trees of Mamre, as he was sitting in the tent door in the heat of the day. 18:2 So he lifted his eyes and looked, and behold, three men were standing by him; and when he saw them, he ran from the tent door to meet them, and bowed himself to the ground, ... 18:8 So he took **butter and milk and the calf** which he had prepared, and set it before them; and he stood by them under the tree **as they ate**. “Keeping kosher” is from Orthodox Rabbinical Judaism.

9) God told the Jewish people that **our Jewish tribal inheritance was from the father's side of the family**. See Num 36:4-6

But Rabbinical Judaism has changed God's Word regarding our Jewishness. Today our Jewishness is taken from the mother's side of the family. Prior, a persons Jewish heritage was always taken from the tribe of the father's family. Read Numbers 36:4-6

10) Soon the Israeli Orthodox religious Jews will begin building their house on Mount Zion hill and begin doing animal sacrifices to the God of Israel. God's Word said that **only a priest from the Aaronic high priest family of the sons of Zadok would ever be allowed to do an animal blood sacrifice to the God of Israel, which God would honor in His Holy Temple**. (Ezekiel 44:15, 16)

Messiah Yeshua is the fulfillment of the high priest family of Zadok. This Truth about Yeshua can be found in 15 separate places in the Scriptures. This is the reason why Yeshua's Eternal Blood Sacrifice was offered and also totally honored by His Father, the Almighty God. Study Jer 33:18; Luke 1:6, 36; Zech 3:1-9; 6:1-13; Ezek 43:18, 19; 44:15, 16,

Therefore I believe that God will never honor any of the Aaronic priest sacrifices done by Orthodox Rabbinical Jews in their coming Jerusalem Temple on Mount Zion hill (on Mount Moriah)... Especially because Yeshua, from this Zadokite high priest family of Aaron had already offered **the ultimate Atonement, His perfect sinless Blood Sacrifice** for the sins of all mankind.

The truest form of biblical Judaism is taken 100% from the Scriptures of the Torah, the Tanakh, and Brit HaDashah, in regards to God's true Messiah and Savior, Yeshua, our King and Great High Priest! The Holy Spirit tabernacles (*dwells*) [in] the world wide Body of all true believers in Yeshua [*The Messiah*].
