Heavy precipitation helps, but winter almost over

Israel's Water Authority confirmed on Thursday that January was one of the wettest months in decades for Northern Israel, but cautioned that it barely makes up for years of drought, adding that the rainy season is more than two thirds over and the Sea of Galilee is still 11 centimeters below the bottom red line at 213.105 meters below sea level. "It was quite a rainy January, especially in the North - we got more rain in the North than in the average year," said Water Authority spokesman Uri Schor. "After the seven drought years we've had, the lack of water is so huge that we need much, much, much more to cover even part of that. We are happy with January, but we can't be satisfied from it. It's not a good situation." With 4.31 meters is still missing from the Kinneret's basin, the Authority offered some hope that the heavier than average snowfall in the country's mountainous regions would, when they thaw in a few months, also make a healthy contribution to the water supply.

Israel ranks high in education

The Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD) recently published its 2011 edition of "Education at a Glance: OECD Indicators," which gave Israel high marks for the levels of education among its citizenry. According to the report, 45% of Israelis have completed a university degree, outranking Japan (44%), the US (41%) and the UK (37%), but trailing Canada (50%). The report also showed Israel as having one of the fastest rates of population growth in the industrialized world and many other indications of positive change in the Jewish State.

Iranian opposition looks for renewal

An Iranian opposition group calling itself the Coordination Council of Green Path of Hope has called for silent rallies in Teheran and other major Iranian cities on 14 February, hoping to revive the revolt against the clerical regime which raged for several months in late 2009 and into early 2010 before being brutally crushed by the Islamic Revolutionary Guards Corps. The group is accusing the government of wasting the countries resources on a futile and pointless struggle against the West, even as the poverty rate among ordinary Iranians has skyrocketed. "We're in a very difficult and dangerous situation," Green Path of Hope spokesman Ardeshir Amir Arjomand told Radio Farda. "The economy is mismanaged, there's growing poverty, [and] economic structures are collapsing."



Israel Vice PM: Military strike can hit all of Iran's nuclear facilities.

All of Iran's nuclear faculties are vulnerable to a military strike, Vice Prime Minister and Strategic Affairs Minister Moshe Ya'alon said on Thursday, calling the potential of a nuclear Iran a "nightmare to the free world."

At the closing day of the Herzliya Conference, Ya'alon referred to the many tools at the international community's disposal that could serve to slow down or stop Iran's advancement toward nuclear weapons capability: international pressure, economic sanctions, support of Iranian opposition, and military actions.

Speaking of the possibility of a military strike of Iran's nuclear facilities, the vice PM said that "the West has the ability to strike, but as long as Iran isn't convinced that there's a determination to follow through with it, they'll continue with their manipulations."

"The Iranians believe that a determination isn't still there, both in regards to military action and in regards to sanctions," Ya'alon said, adding that "any facility protected by humans can be infiltrated by humans. It's possible to strike all Iran's facilities, and I say that out of my experience as IDF chief of staff."

The vice PM's comments seem to counter reported remarks by U.S. defense officials quoted last week by the Wall Street Journal, according to which the Pentagon was not in possession of conventional arms strong enough to destroy all of Iran's nuclear facilities.

Ya'alon reiterated the Israeli stance that a nuclear Iran was a global threat, saying that "if Iran obtains nuclear weapons, it would be a nightmare for the free world, a nightmare for Arab states...and of course a threat to the State of Israel."

"We'll see a more intense undermining of regional regimes and the acceleration of terror attacks against those regimes, as well as against Israel and western states, with the United States at the forefront," Ya'alon said.

The former IDF chief also indicated that an explosion which virtually destroyed an Iran Revolutionary Guard missile base near Tehran late last year targeted a system "getting ready to produce a missile with a range of 10,000 kilometers, thus threatening the United States."

"The Iranian threat is not a case of Iran Vs. Israel. Israel has never declared war on Iran, but the Khomeinistic regime has declared total war on the States of Israel's very existence," Ya'alon added, saying that Iran was interested in repelling a perceived western hegemony around the world and not just in the Middle East.

Ya'alon's comments came after, earlier Thursday, Military Intelligence Chief Major General Aviv Kochavi said that Iran's ability to obtain nuclear weapons was solely dependent on the will of Iranian Supreme Leader Ayatollah Ali Khamenei, adding that Israel was threatened by about 200,000 missiles at any given time.



Netanyahu to UN: No New Construction Freeze in Judea, Samaria

Prime Minister Binyamin Netanyahu bluntly told United Nations Secretary-General Ban Ki-moon on Wednesday there will be no new construction freeze in Judea and Samaria.

Ban asked Israel earlier in the day to reinstate the freeze on all construction in Jewish communities in the region, saying at a news conference it was "not helpful" to the peace process.

But Netanyahu noted out that any discussion about a freeze on construction -- or any other action taken by Israel to move the peace process forward -- should come in context of the process itself, rather than as a precondition.

"This issue is part of the negotiations," he told Ban. "It can't be a precondition."

Netanyahu added pointedly that "settlements are not the crux of the conflict, but rather, one of its outcomes. The conflict started 50 years before there were settlements."

In addition to his meeting in Jerusalem with Netanyahu, Ban met with President Shimon Peres and Foreign Minister Avigdor Lieberman. He is also set to meet with Defense Minister Ehud Barak, as well as Opposition leader and Kadima party chairwoman Tzipi Livni, prior to leaving the region.

Speaking to reporters after meeting Tuesday in Jordan with King Abdullah II and Foreign Minister Nasser Judeh, Ban urged Netanyahu to revive a construction freeze in Judea and Samaria as a "goodwill gesture" to Palestinian Authority Chairman Mahmoud Abbas. In addition, Ban urged Israel to submit its own proposals for borders and security arrangements to PA/PLO officials.

"Of course, it would also be required that PA authorities come to dialogue," Ban said, clearly hoping that the Fatah leader, who also heads the PLO, would be enticed to return to talks by a new freeze.

Netanyahu promised Israelis after a 10-month construction freeze which resulted in nothing but a handful of photo ops that he would not allow Israel to be forced into another one.

During that time, Jews living even 15 minutes from the capital were unable to pave a driveway to their homes, add a pergola to shade a front porch in summer, or make simple repairs to existing structures. Buildings in progress were unable to be completed, schools could not add classrooms and homes that had been started were forced to be abandoned -- throwing many families' financial affairs into total chaos.

Ban is scheduled to visit Gaza Thursday before stopping at Sapir College, near Sderot -- an area repeatedly peppered by Qassam rocket attacks launched by Gaza terrorists. He will then travel to Herzliya to deliver the keynote address at the IDC Herzliya Conference.



'It May Be Too Late to Attack Iran after the Summer'

The constant chatter about a possible Israeli attack on Iran's nuclear site may end by the summer. After that, the military option may fall off the table, according to sources.

The current weapons in use against Iran are sanctions, which now are harsher than ever, cyber warfare such as last year's Stuxnet attack, and subversive assassinations from within Iran and which have eliminated dozens of nuclear scientists and Revolutionary Guard officers the past three years.

Israel is worried the latest sanctions came too late to stop Iran, which has buried its nuclear facilities under concrete bunkers and in isolated mountainous areas to make them more immune to an attack. Israel is armed with American-made bunker busting bombs, long-range drones, submarines and long-range warplanes. Iran claims it can easily attack Israel with its missiles.

The question marks are on how much damage Israel can do and how much damage Iran can do to Israel if it stages a counter attack. Another concern is the possibility that Lebanon's Hezbollah terrorist organization would attack Israel with tens of thousands of missiles.

The clock may have the final say, according to the media reports based on sources who say that after mid-summer, the military option will be off the table. "It seems to us to be urgent, because the Iranians are deliberately drifting into what we call an immunity zone where practically no surgical operation could block them," Defense Minister Ehud Barak said at the World Economic Forum in Davos, Switzerland last Friday. He added, "We are determined to prevent Iran from turning nuclear."

The sanctions are a two-edged sword, As late as they have come, the United States and other Western countries can claim that Israel must give them time to work. The Iranian economy is known to be suffering, the local currency is in shambles and inflation is sky-high.

An Israeli attack on Iran could cause a worldwide economic crisis if Iran blocks the passage of oil and tankers through the Strait of Hormuz and also could cause a diplomatic crisis as well as all-out war - unless a surgical strike is swift and successful.

Yiftakh Shapir, an expert in nuclear arms proliferation at Tel Aviv University, told the Associated Press, "What will tip the scales in favor or against an attack is whether we will really be able to do inflict serious damage." He said it would take massive assaults lasting nearly a month to destroy Iran's fortified nuclear facilities. Until the summer, it may not be surprising if there are more "mysterious" deaths in Iran.
