Saudis 'would let Israeli jets use their air space to attack Iran'

Saudi Arabia is prepared to let Israeli fighter jets use its airspace if it proves necessary to attack Iran's nuclear program, an Israeli TV station reported Tuesday, highlighting growing ties in the shadow of Tehran's nuclear drive.

Riyadh's only condition is that Israel make some kind of progress in peace talks with the Palestinians, Channel 2 reported Tuesday, citing an unnamed senior European source. "The Saudi authorities are completely coordinated with Israel on all matters related to Iran," the European official in Brussels said.

Jerusalem and Riyadh do not have diplomatic ties, but unconfirmed reports have swirled for years of coordination between them against the common enemy of Iran, a partnership that may ramp up should the world powers reach a reportedly emerging deal that would allow Tehran to continue enriching some uranium.

The report claimed the Saudi authorities had made their position clear in various unspecified diplomatic discussions on the matter.

"The Saudis have declared their readiness for the Israeli Air Force to overfly Saudi air space en route to attack Iran if an attack is necessary," the TV report said. All that they ask is "some kind of progress" on the Palestinian issue.

Being able to use Saudi airspace would allow Israeli planes a shortcut to reach Iran without having to fly around the Persian Gulf, taking up precious time and fuel.

According to the dispatch, Israel and Saudi Arabia also share intelligence on Iran's nuclear program at a very intimate level and the Saudis are no less worried by details coming out of the Geneva talks than Israeli leaders, who have loudly spoken out against the talks.

Tuesday's report comes amid increased tensions between the White House and Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu over how best to tackle Tehran's nuclear program.

Britain, China, France, Russia, the United States and Germany - known as the P5+1 - have been seeking a comprehensive accord with Iran that would prevent Tehran from developing a nuclear bomb in return for an easing of economic sanctions.

Netanyahu has warned repeatedly that the Islamic Republic must not be allowed to acquire nuclear weapons, although Iranian officials insist the nuclear program is purely for civilian use.

There is a heightened sense of urgency as the clock ticks down towards a March 31 deadline to agree on a political framework for the deal.

'Jihadi John' identified: ISIS killer named as Mohammed Emwazi from West London

The British Islamic State militant who has featured in videos featuring the execution of Western hostages, known as 'Jihadi John', has been identified.

The militant is Mohammed Emwazi, a young British man from West London who was known to British security services.

Security agencies did not disclose his name earlier due to operational



reasons.

Emwazi is thought to have killed American journalist James Foley in a video released last August.

He is further believed to have featured in the videos of the beheadings of US journalist Steven Sotloff, British aid worker David Haines, British taxi driver Alan Henning, and US aid worker Abdul-Rahman Kassig, also known as Peter.

Emwazi is reported to have links with a former UK control order suspect who fled to Somalia in 2006 and has alleged links to the funding of militant group Al Shabab, which recently threatened to carry out terror attacks on London's Oxford Street.

He is a computing graduate from Queen's Park in West London, who traveled to Syria in 2012 and later joined the Islamic State (IS, formerly ISIS).

One of his friends told the Washington Post he had "no doubt" that "Mohammed is Jihadi John."

"He was like a brother to me ... I am sure it is him. There was an extremely strong resemblance. This is making me feel fairly certain that this is the same person," he added.

Israeli fighter jets stage warning passes against Syrian air force intruders over Golan. Air tension high

Israeli fighter jets flew passes over the Golan Monday, Feb. 23 as a warning to Syrian helicopters and fighter planes to stop encroaching on the no-fly zone, in violation of standing Israeli-Syrian armistice agreements. This is reported by military sources.

The Syrian warplanes planes came over Quneitra Monday to drop barrel bombs on Syrian rebel forces holding the town. Spotters on Israeli Golan counted at least 30 bombs dropped by helicopters under cover of Syrian air force jets. Their crews took no notice of the Israeli fighter jets and drones present at the time and continued their attacks regardless.

At the end of the Syrian operation, Israeli aircraft conducted its warning passes over the Golan town.

Our sources report that this was the second day in a row that the Syrian air force had bombed the same sector. Sunday, they struck rebel positions in the Tel Al-Harra area 6-8 km from the Israeli Golan border. Israel's inaction then encouraged Damascus to move its warplanes closer to the border the next day and fly into the no-fly zone.

This time, Israeli avoided a direct clash, but broadcast a warning that a confrontation was possible if the Syrians returned for a repeat. Western and Middle East military sources interpret the Israeli flights over Quneitra Monday as a clear warning to Damascus that Israel will not tolerate Syrian air raids close to its Golan lines or any incursions in airspace banned by their armistice agreements.

Six months ago, on Sept. 23, an Israeli Patriot air defense battery downed a Syrian Sukhoi-24 which ventured into its air space. The plane crashed just inside the Syrian border. The IDF claimed at the time that the Syrian plane had strayed across the border by mistake - and so the incident ended. However, Israeli

commanders were certain that there was no mistake and that the Syrians were testing the alertness of Israel's air defenses and gauging its readiness to deploy its air might for challenging aerial incursions.

IDF Installs Concrete Barriers Along Syrian Border

The IDF has placed concrete barriers along the Syrian borderfollowing the antitank missile attack from Hezbollah last month in the Golan Heights.

"Following the increase in threats to IDF soldiers patrolling the border, and for fear of similar events, it was decided to increase in various ways the security measures in the area, including placing concrete blocs," a senior military source stated.

On January 28, Major Yochai Kalengal and Sgt. Dor Chaim Nini were killed after Hezbollah terrorists shot between 4-6 antitank missiles into Israel, near Har Dov in the Golan Heights. The attack also injured six additional soldiers, and a Spanish UNIFIL peacekeeper was killed in retaliatory fire from Israel.

Initial investigations into the incident revealed Sunday that Military Intelligence (MI) may have warned the IDF Northern Command about the possibility of the attack ahead of time - and that the IDF may have stalled on taking preventative measures against the threat.

In the days before the attack, Hezbollah made multiple threats against Israel, after an IAF airstrike in Syria killed one of its senior terrorists, along with five other Hezbollah terrorists and an Iranian general - all of whom were scouting to plan an attack on the Golan Heights.

Iran airlifts thousands of Shiite fighters to Syrian port of Latakia to boost Aleppo warfront

Military and intelligence sources have discovered a large-scale Iranian airlift is in progress for bringing thousands of Shiite fighters to the Syrian Mediterranean port of Latakia to reinforce the Syrian army forces falling back from the key city of Aleppo. Some of the flights are taking off from Baghdad airport.

The Syrian rebels in heavy fighting Thursday and Friday, Feb. 19-20 repulsed a Hizballah-backed Syrian army offensive to recapture the town and took scores of Hizballah fighters prisoner.

The incoming reinforcements are being transferred directly to the Aleppo battle-front in an effort to stabilize it and reverse the Syrian army's retreat.

The incoming reinforcements are made up of Iraqi, Afghan and Pakistani Shiite militiamen. The fact that Tehran was able to raise this force in less than 24 hours from the Syrian army's defeat in Aleppo demonstrates Iran's total military and strategic commitment to swift action for averting a Syrian-Hizballah retreat from a key front of the four-year old civil war.

The Iranian planes are taking two routes to Syria, starting out either in Baghdad or Tehran. In Baghdad, they touch down in the military section of the

international airport and collect the Iraqi Shiite militiamen destined for the Syrian battlefield. This step necessitated the consent of the Iraqi government and Prime Minister Haider al-Abadi.

The Iranian operation therefore exposes two exceedingly disturbing developments which are causing Israel's army chiefs to burn the midnight oil: The fall of the Abadi government under Tehran's sway is one; and Iraq's direct involvement for the first time in the military actions of the Syrian civil war.

Military experts extrapolate from Tehran's immediate readiness to transfer thousands of foreign troops into Syria to save Assad's army from retreat, that the same response is to be expected from a possible setback of the same alliance in South Syria - especially when Iranian Revolutionary Guards officers are leading a Syrian-Hizballah-Shiite drive to capture the Golan town of Quneitra across from Israel's lines.

Our sources add that President Barack Obama was in a position, had he wished, to intervene with Baghdad and hold back the Iranian troop airlift to Syria. This has not happened.

The administration's inaction places it squarely behind Iran's military steps in the Middle East and its direct intervention in key trouble spots.

Netanyahu speech controversy still raging

The planned address to the US Congress by Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu scheduled for 3 March continued to generate headlines in the US and Israel on Tuesday.

Susan Rice, US President Barack Obama's national security advisor, told CBS's Charlie Rose that the address will be "destructive of the fabric of the relationship" because "what has happened over the last several weeks, by virtue of the invitation that was issued by the Speaker and the acceptance of it by Prime Minister Netanyahu on two weeks in advance of his election, is that on both sides, there has now been injected a degree of partisanship."

Sisi calls for united Arab front against IS

Egyptian president Abdel Fattah al-Sisi gave a nationally televised speech Monday in which he declared that Arab governments must unite in order to battle the increasing threat from the Islamic State (IS) terror militia. Reports out of Jordan, Egypt and the UAE indicate moves towards greater Arab coordination in the fight against IS.

Meanwhile, on Tuesday, US Secretary of State John Kerry testified before the Senate Foreign Relations Committee in Washington on Tuesday, saying among other things that US ground troops would not be used in the battle against IS under the legal mandate for military force President Obama is requesting from Congress. The request for an official Authorization of the Use of Military Force (AUMF) argues that local forces would be trained and equipped to do the fighting while US Special Operations forces would have the "flexibility" to participate in local actions on a case by case basis
