Palestinian forces detain 500 Hamas West Bankers, to thwart coup and Abbas assassination plot

Acting on direct orders from Palestinian Authority Chairman Mahmoud Abbas, Palestinian special forces raided the nine PA-ruled towns of the West Bank in the past 48 hours and detained 500 Hamas suspects, military sources report.

Abbas ordered the operation after discovering that Hamas had been hatching a plot for some weeks to stage an armed insurrection against the Palestinian Authority, starting in one of the Palestinian towns - possibly even the PA capital of Ramallah. They would assassinate him in the process of the coup.

Of late, Abbas has kept his distance from Ramallah and his seat of government and spends most of his time traveling in foreign countries, especially Arab capitals, where he feels safer under the protection of foreign security services than he does at home.

The wave of detentions from Sunday to Tuesday (March 9-10) is the most extensive the Palestinian Authority has ever conducted against Hamas' West Bank cells. Not only prominent figures and known terror activists were taken into custody but also new figures. Abbas ordered the operation amid a serious dilemma over his personal security.

Before him were reports presented by Palestinian Intelligence chief Maj. Gen. Majed Faraj revealing the preparations in train for his assassination, an event that would signal mass riots orchestrated by Hamas and Jihad Islami, leading up to the seizure of government from the Palestinian Authority - much as they did in the Gaza Strip. At the same time, Abbas does not entirely trust Palestinian security services or their ability to safeguard him and his regime in Ramallah.

He therefore turned to Israel, touching off an IDF response that had nothing to do with Israel's forthcoming general election on March 17 - as government opponents have claimed.

The 3,000 IDF soldiers plus 10,000 reservists called up this week were not posted on the West Bank to practice anti-riot tactics for putting down Palestinians disturbances against Jewish settlements - as reported. They were placed on the ready in case it was necessary to go into Palestinian towns and save them from being overrun by the radical Hamas and Jihad Islami.

The Israeli troops also rehearsed a possible scenario that might ensue from the murder of Mahmoud Abbas.

In view of the highly sensitive security situation on the West Bank, Prime Minister Binyamin Netanyahu accompanied by Defense Minister Moshe Ya'alon, paid a rare visit to the IDF's Judea-Samaria command headquarters Tuesday, March 10, to inspect these preparations.

It was the Hamas conspiracy to seize power in Ramallah that prompted Ya'alon's enigmatic remark that were it not for preemptive military operations, central Israel might now be under missile and mortar attack.

Military sources add that way the Palestinian issue has become a football for kicking around Israel's election campaign, making it hard to

penetrate the fog of anti-government propaganda and establish what is really going on

For example, Netanyahu is being presented by his rivals as having agreed at a former stage in US-brokered peace negotiations with the Palestinians to withdraw to behind the 1967 lines. They have picked out one of the many papers drawn up by the Americans and discarded in the course of the negotiations - this one was written by a Shiite Iraqi academic in Oxford University and was never approved either by Israel or the Palestinians.

Turning to the real events afoot today, our sources also reveal that the PA chairman has asked Netanyahu through back-channels for a secret rendezvous somewhere in Europe. He proposed avoiding prominent capitals like London, Paris or Berlin, but meeting at a smaller venue for the sake of confidentiality.

Abbas also insisted that this meeting must be concealed from Washington, especially from Secretary of State John Kerry. The Israeli prime minister has turned him down - and not just because the Palestinian request finds him in the middle of a tough race for re-election.

Revealed: Hamas, West and Israel in Talks for 5-Year Ceasefire

Despite its recent threats to kidnap IDF soldiers, Hamas is more than willing to sign a long-term cease-fire agreement - sometime in the near future, according to local news reports.

The terror group recently conveyed a series of messages to Israel which express interest in an agreement in exchange for lifting Israel's transport, import, and export restrictions on Gaza, Hamas and Israeli government sources revealed to the daily news.

The proposals, among other things, would have scaled back Hamas's vows to wage an "armed struggle" and obliterate Israel entirely, and would even include an agreement to a Palestinian state with eastern Jerusalem as its capital, the documents state.

Israeli government sources confirmed that Hamas began talks with Western mediators due to the "difficult situation" in Gaza, which COGAT recently stated is in dire need of water and other resources.

Diplomats mentioned as mediators include outgoing United Nations (UN) envoy to the Middle East Robert Serry and Swiss ambassador to the Palestinian Authority (PA) Paul Granier - both of whom became the prime representatives between Israel and Hamas.

As part of the negotiations, Garnier visited Gaza last month and met with top terror leaders, including Musa Abu Marzouk, Bassem Naim, Ghazi Hamad and others.

During his talks, Hamas officials made it clear that they are willing to agree to a ceasefire for at least five years (some sources claim this is fifteen years), which will stop all military operations "above and below ground," between Hamas and Israel.

In exchange, however, Israel would have to remove all restrictions on travel, exports, and imports on Gaza - a move sure to allow the terror group to accelerate the rebuilding of its weapons arsenal via Iran and other international backers. Hamas admitted earlier this month that it is already producing rockets to attack Israel again. A Hamas official confirmed that the group is aware that nothing will happen before the Israeli elections next week, however.

Days after Garnier visited Gaza, Hamas presented a document outlining their platform to Quartet envoy Tony Blair. The document, in English, allows for an establishment of a Palestinian state along 1949 Armistice lines, claims it has "a moderate ideology" that "believes in positive dialogue between different civilizations with no recourse to violence or oppression," and that their agenda is specifically against Israelis, "not against the Jewish people per se."

Hamas claims that it is "interested in maintaining calm" and that it wants to construct an airport and seaport, coordinating with Israel through various mediators to do so.

Internally, the group stresses that it "respects the rights of women," wants to reconcile with various Palestinian factions (despite multiple reports of a crackdown on Fatah in Gaza), and "has taken all necessary measures and made concessions needed for reconciliation [with Fatah - ed.]."

The document, after these manifestos, is signed, "The Islamic Resistance Movement - Hamas."

Hours after the initial report was published, Serry clarified that his proposal to Hamas extended for three to five years - not fifteen - and while it included a lift on transport and import restrictions, it would also place Gaza under the "unity" government, i.e. the PA. PA 'prime minister' Rami Hamdallah would be given exclusive sovereignty over the region, without their involvement, he said; he added that both Israel and Hamas have yet to respond.

Hamas spokesman Sami Abu Zuhri has denied Hamas's involvement in talks following the exposé.

Egypt faces 'existential threat' from ISIS

The Egyptian president's call for increased U.S. military aid this week was in direct response to information regarding plans for a major Islamic insurgency aimed at toppling Abdel Fattah al-Sisi's secular regime.

A senior Egyptian intelligence official said there is information ISIS has united with other jihadist groups and is planning an unprecedented surge inside Egypt to possibly begin as soon as next month.

The official said Cairo estimates the Sisi regime could face an existential threat from the planned insurgency.



He warned that if the moderate Sisi regime is toppled, the Middle East will become far less stable. "This is a very different story from anything that happening in last two to three years," he said, referring to the planned

insurgency.

Just Monday, bomb attacks in the Sinai Peninsula targeted the police and army. This past Sunday, the Egyptian military said it killed 70 suspected militants in northern Sinai the first week of March and arrested 23 others in counter-terror raids.

In December, Egypt arrested dozens of foreign jihadists in the Sinai Peninsula, stoking fears ISIS militants were seeking to open a new front.

In February, thousands of foreign jihadists were attempting to infiltrate Egypt, with plans of a coming destabilization campaign akin to the insurgency in Syria, according to informed Middle Eastern security officials.

The officials warned at the time of a troubling development taking place among the al-Qaida-linked organizations already inside Egypt. They said there is information the militant groups are forming a de facto chain of command, with alarming coordination between the various jihadist factions embedded around the country.

The terrorist infrastructure is being set up beyond the Islamist stronghold of the Sinai Peninsula.

The officials said al-Qaida-linked groups in Egypt have been forming divisions replete with leadership and assignments to specific territories, including in the Sinai, Suez regions, outside Cairo and along the Delta.

Now Sisi is appealing to the Obama administration and international community for help in battling the insurgency.

In a Fox News interview, Sisi appealed for an increase in U.S. military aid. "It is very important for the United States to understand that our need for the weapons and for the equipment is dire, especially at the time when the Egyptians feel they are fighting terrorism and they would like to feel the United States is standing by them in that fight against terrorism," he said.

Secretary of State John Kerry is due in Egypt on Thursday for the Egypt Economic Development Conference, where he will meet with Sisi and discuss regional cooperation.

Iran Declares Pre-emptive Victory in Nuke Talks

Iran's foreign minister and chief negotiator in nuclear talks with the West declared victory for his country, stating that no matter how the negotiations end, Tehran has come out "the winner," according to remarks made on Tuesday and presented in the country's state-run press.

Javad Zarif, the Islamic Republic's foreign minister, stated in remarks before the country's powerful Assembly of Experts, which recently installed a hardline new cleric as its leader, that the nuclear negotiations have established Tehran as a global power broker.

"We are the winner whether the [nuclear] negotiations yield results or not," Zarif was quoted as saying before the assembly by the Tasnim News Agency. "The capital we have obtained over the years is dignity and self-esteem, a capital that could not be retaken."
