Obama Administration De-Classifies Top Secret Document that Reveals Israel's Nuclear Secrets

In a development that has largely been missed by mainstream media, the Pentagon early last month quietly declassified a Department of Defense top-secret document detailing Israel's nuclear program, a highly covert topic that Israel has never formally announced to avoid a regional nuclear arms race, and which the US until now has respected by remaining silent.

But by publishing the declassified document from 1987, the US reportedly breached the silent agreement to keep quiet on Israel's nuclear powers for the first time ever, detailing the nuclear program in great depth.

The timing of the revelation is highly suspect, given that it came as tensions spiraled out of control between Prime Minister Binyamin Netanyahu and US President Barack Obama ahead of Netanyahu's March 3 address in Congress, in which he warned against the dangers of Iran's nuclear program and how the deal being formed on that program leaves the Islamic regime with nuclear breakout capabilities.

Another highly suspicious aspect of the document is that while the Pentagon saw fit to declassify sections on Israel's sensitive nuclear program, it kept sections on Italy, France, West Germany and other NATO countries classified, with those sections blocked out in the document.

The 386-page report entitled "Critical Technological Assessment in Israel and NATO Nations" gives a detailed description of how Israel advanced its military technology and developed its nuclear infrastructure and research in the 1970s and 1980s.

Israel is "developing the kind of codes which will enable them to make hydrogen bombs. That is, codes which detail fission and fusion processes on a microscopic and macroscopic level," reveals the report, stating that in the 1980s Israelis were reaching the ability to create bombs considered a thousand times more powerful than atom bombs.

The revelation marks a first in which the US published in a document a description of how Israel attained hydrogen bombs.

The report also notes research laboratories in Israel "are equivalent to our Los Alamos, Lawrence Livermore and Oak Ridge National Laboratories," the key labs in developing America's nuclear arsenal. Israel's nuclear infrastructure is "an almost exact parallel of the capability currently existing at our National Laboratories," it adds.

"As far as nuclear technology is concerned the Israelis are roughly where the U.S. was in the fission weapon field in about 1955 to 1960," the report reveals, noting a time frame just after America tested its first hydrogen bomb. Institute for Defense Analysis, a federally funded agency operating under the Pentagon, penned the report back in 1987.



Aside from nuclear capabilities, the report revealed Israel at the time had "a totally integrated effort in systems development throughout the nation," with electronic combat all in one "integrated system, not separated systems for the Army, Navy and Air Force."

It even acknowledged that in some cases, Israeli military technology "is more advanced than in the U.S."

Declassifying the report comes at a sensitive timing as noted above, and given that the process to have it published was started three years ago, that timing is seen as having been the choice of the American government.

US journalist Grant Smith petitioned to have the report published based on the Freedom of Information Act. Initially the Pentagon took its time answering, leading Smith to sue, and a District Court judge to order the Pentagon to respond to the request.

Smith, who heads the Institute for Research: Middle East Policy, reportedly said he thinks this is the first time the US government has officially confirmed that Israel is a nuclear power, a status that Israel has long been widely known to have despite being undeclared.

U.S. 'ignoring intel' on ISIS chemical attacks

Egypt provided the United States with information that ISIS is attempting to purchase chemical materials such as chlorine gas that can be utilized in terrorist attacks, an Egyptian intelligence official said.

Yet the official claimed the U.S. has been "ignoring" the intelligence as well as information ISIS has already utilized chlorine gas in attacks against Kurdish forces in recent weeks, including in battles in Tikrit, Iraq.

The developments came after a British chemical weapons expert who advised security forces in Baghdad issued a warning that returning ISIS fighters could purchase chemical materials and carry out attacks against civilian targets in the U.S. or U.K.

Last weekend, the Kurdistan Regional Security Council in Iraq claimed ISIS deployed weaponized chlorine gas in recent surges. The substance is banned on the battlefield by the international Chemical Weapons Convention.

"The analysis, which was carried out at an EU-certified laboratory, found the samples contained levels of chlorine that suggested the substance was used in weaponized form," Kurdish officials wrote in a statement released to the news media.

The Kurdish group further claimed Peshmerga forces discovered "20 gas canisters" in the back of a truck used in an ISIS suicide bomb attack in Iraq on Jan. 23.

Kurdish forces released video and photos purporting to show an exploding truck storming down a road leaving a trail of orange smoke, a sign of chlorine gas.

One Kurdish official told reports that "dozens" of Peshmerga fighters were treated for "dizziness, nausea, vomiting and general weakness" after the attack.

Last week, a chemical weapons expert warned ISIS militants returning from fighting overseas could carry out chemical attacks inside the U.S. or U.K., perhaps on transportation infrastructure or at a sports stadium.

Hamish de Bretton-Gordon, a former commanding officer at the Joint Chemical Biological Radiological Nuclear Regiment, warned, "It is very evident that ISIS are putting much time and effort into training its jihadis in the use of chlorine as a terror weapon and in particular in IEDs (improvised explosive devices)."

Bretton-Gordon continued, "Virtually every foreign jihadi who returns to

the U.S. or U.K. will have been exposed to training of this sort and will have a reasonable idea on how to use chlorine and other toxic chemicals as a terror weapon."

Bretton-Gordon pointed out that in the U.K. at least, up to 90 tons of chlorine can be purchased without a license.

When he returned earlier this month from advising security forces in Baghdad, Bretton-Gordon told the London Daily Mirror newspaper that a chlorine gas attack within the U.K. was "highly likely...This could happen on a train or tube or even at a big football match."

Military Officials Say Hezbollah on the Brink of War

The Lebanon-Israel border has been relatively quiet over the past several months, with no incidents recorded since January. But another war could be on the way and it will cost billions of shekels, experts say.

Military Intelligence officials, the IDF, and the defense establishment are all preparing for an inevitable full-fledged war with Hezbollah, due, at least in part, to the increasing boldness of Hezbollah leader Hassan Nasrallah.

"Today more than ever, Nasrallah is willing to take risks with Israel that could get out of hand, instead of being perceived by Israel as weak," a senior defense official told the daily.

As such, Hezbollah has become more brazen in its open readiness to attack Israel, military sources stated. According to several IDF reports, Hezbollah terrorists have begun openly patrolling up and down the border - sometimes in civilian clothing, sometimes wearing Lebanese Army uniforms - and documenting on camera what happens each day on the border fence and documenting "engineering work."

Foreign sources have stated that Hezbollah terrorists have begun openly walking through Shi'ite villages in Lebanon as well - despite the patrol of Lebanese Army soldiers and UNIFIL peacekeepers.

The organization has become involved in a drug smuggling trade between Lebanon and Israel as well, in order to perform useful reconnaissance for future battles with Israel. "Nothing has been done in southern Lebanon, and probably on the Gaza border, without the organization knowing it," a senior military source in the Northern Command said.

The IDF is preparing for the possibility of another war, attempting to match the IDF's strength to intel gathered on Hezbollah's firepower.

But it is also prepared for specific scenarios - including the likelihood of Hezbollah's special forces, consisting of 100-200 terrorists, raiding communities near the Lebanese border fence and occupying them for short periods. The group has changed tactics to be more on the offensive, the source added.

Rumors have persisted for months that terror tunnels are being dug into Israel. In January, residents along the Lebanon-Israel border stated that they would fund their own investigation team to examine the possibility of Hezbollah digging terror tunnels into Israel, after the IDF reportedly denied repeatedly that there was any evidence of digging.

When asked about the digging noises earlier this year, Defense Minister Moshe Ya'alon (Likud) claimed "no tunnels have been located on the northern border. Noises that were heard beneath a home turned out to be a neighbor's horse stomping with its hooves." But a video posted on YouTube shortly thereafter, [of the motorised ~600 RPM mechanical beat emanating from a sink drain hole, *BGEMC Ed.*] said to have been filmed at night in Shtula on the border with Lebanon, had many seriously doubting Ya'alon's claims. www.youtube.com/watch?v=2mQHYFb2t84

The security establishment has not found any evidence of tunnels so far - or so it claims publicly - but the IDF assures that it is preparing for the scenario of a surprise attack.

However, Division 91 sources stated that Hezbollah may not even need tunnels to infiltrate Israel; if the group decides to storm the border, it could reach Kibbutz Misgav in minutes - tunnels or not.

If necessary, a war against Hezbollah will be costly - to the tune of 1.5 billion shekels (\$378 million) per day of fighting, security forces say. Thus, Israel's political system will be forced to decide - and soon - whether to choose increased deterrence or wait until war along the borders to prevent the most casualties and crippling economic damage.

IDF Gearing Up for Conflict in Judea, Samaria

The IDF is preparing for the possibility of a conflagration in Judea and Samaria. Central Command is carrying out training exercises and acquiring the needed equipment for dealing with the threat.

The reasons for the assessment that a violent confrontation is near include the tense atmosphere in diplomatic relations between Israel and the Palestinian Authority (PA), the PA's complaint against Israel at the International Criminal Court in the Hague, and Israel's freezing of PA tax revenues in response, the report says.

"At this point, Abu Mazen has a vested interest in maintaining stability on the ground," IDF officials said, referring to PA Chairman Mahmoud Abbas by his kunya name. But as time goes by, they said, matters may deteriorate into violence.

The main cause for potential Arab anger, in the IDF's view, is Israel's freezing of PA tax revenues. Israel has thus far frozen about NIS 1.5 billion in the course of three months, in addition to another NIS 1 billion that were already frozen.

On the other hand, the number of work permits for PA Arabs who seek employment in Israel has been increased.

Israel has identified a rise in the coordination of terror activities in Judea and Samaria by elements in Gaza, and by Hamas's Saleh Aruri, who resides in Turkey. In addition, there is "an awakening" of Fatah-Tanzim activity, and Islamic Jihad has also increased its activity, especially in Samaria.

The IDF is preparing for different scenarios, including wide-scale rioting and "different kinds of violence," the official adds. The PA may direct the violence in a way that is designed to increase international opprobrium against Israel.
