Official: Hezbollah Hiding 100,000 Rockets in Civilian Areas

A senior Israeli military intelligence official warned Wednesday of a heightened threat of conflict on Israel's borders in the next two years as a result of "escalation" in the region.

In a briefing to foreign journalists at the Defense Ministry in Tel Aviv, the official also said Israel would likely "have to" target civilian areas in Lebanon in a future confrontation with Hezbollah, given its distribution of weapons sites.

The official's warning came after a Hezbollah attack killed two Israeli soldiers in January, raising fears of another all-out war, and as Israel continues to rail against a full nuclear deal between world powers and Iran.

"If we speak about a war that one country or one organization will all of a sudden start against Israel, the probability is even lower than it was two or three years ago," said the official, who requested that his name not be used. "But the probability for war as a result of escalation... or miscalculation is much higher than it was in the past, because of the situation of organizations around Israel."

The official referred specifically to Hezbollah, with whom Israel fought a monthlong war in 2006, and Iran's arming of the group. "The Iranian threat is a tangible threat to Israel. Iran has an aspiration to rule, to control the Middle East," he said. "One of the tools Iran uses in order to implement this policy is Hezbollah."

The official added that a nuclear deal with Iran allowing the Islamic republic to prosper economically would likely lead to more funding of its proxies in the region, such as Hezbollah.

The army official warned that in a future conflict with Hezbollah, Israel would "have to" target civilian areas.

He said Hezbollah currently possesses more than 100,000 rockets hidden in civilian areas in Lebanese villages that could hit northern Israel, including "hundreds" which could reach anywhere in the Jewish state.

"Each (village) is a military stronghold. Next time we have a war with Hezbollah, we will have to attack each one of these targets, and we hope the population will not be there," he said.

In March, military experts stated that Hezbollah is close to declaring war, and that terrorists openly stroll along the Israel-Lebanon border.

To prepare, sources said, the IDF is preparing a variety of scenarios - including the likelihood of Hezbollah's special forces, consisting of 100-200 terrorists, raiding communities near the Lebanese border fence and occupying them for short periods.

Both statements follow persistent reports from northern Israelis that they have heard, or seen, evidence of terror tunnel digging along the borders; the IDF has said it is investigating the area for tunnels.



250 Hizballah dead in Qalamoun battle. Nasrallah pushes Lebanese army to enter Syrian war

Amid Hizballah's rising war losses, its leader Hassan Nasrallah strongly urged the Lebanese chief of staff Gen. Jean Kahwagi to send his troops into battle over the strategic Qalamoun Mountain, alongside Hizballah and the Syrian army, military sources disclose.

Nasrallah argued that the time had come for the Lebanese army to take a hand in the fighting, since the Syrian rebels led by Al Qaeda's Syrian arm, the Nusra Front, were shelling the eastern Beqaa Valley of Lebanon from their Syrian strongholds on the mountain that sits athwart the Syrian-Lebanese border. Thousands of jihadis, he said, were seizing land around the northeastern Lebanese villages of Arsal and Nahleh.

Another of Nasrallah's demands was for Gen. Kahwagi to bring out the Lebanese army's heavy artillery to shell rebel Qalamoun concentrations, positions and moving vehicles, because they endangered Lebanese national security.

The Lebanese general gave the Hizballah chief a flat no. He declared the Lebanese army would not "slip" into any war inside the Syrian area of Qalamoun where Hizballah and the Syrian army are currently fighting jihadis, but added: "The army is ready to confront any assault on Lebanese sovereignty and push back any infiltration by militants."

Tuesday, May 12, in Beirut, US Ambassador David Hale interceded in the argument: "I would say that ISIS posed no threat to Lebanon until Hizballah went into the war in Syria and that provided the magnet that drew these terrorists here."

Listing the American weapons reaching Beirut of late, as Hellfire missiles fired from helicopters against ground targets, precision guided missiles and howitzers, the ambassador said firmly: "This is exactly what they (the Lebanese army) need to target this particular terrorism phenomenon."

Military and counter-terrorism sources don't believe that the Lebanese army chief will be able to hold out for long against the gradual ISIS and Nusra slide into his country. At the moment, the intruders are mostly fleeing Islamists, driven by the Syrian army and Hizballah from their mountain positions and out of the eastern Lebanese border districts close to the battle front.

But although the Syrian army and Hizballah are claiming to have taken strategic hills in the volatile border region last week, the battle is far from over and does not appear to be anywhere near a clear resolution.

Even when Syria and Hizballah do achieve a local gain here or there, fresh ISIS and Nusra forces keep on pouring back - mostly from the north - to constantly open up new battlefronts on the Qalamoun mountains. Their commanders have already grasped that no one will stop them slipping back and forth between Syria and Lebaon - both to escape Syrian and Hizballah fire and meanwhile to hit Hizballah's rear strongholds in the Lebanese Beqaa.

Hizballah's death toll in battle is soaring disastrously - at least 250 reported in the last few days, including 9 senior commanders.

Most military and intelligence experts agree that, as time goes by,



however hard they try, the United States and Lebanese army will not be able to stem the jihadists' spillover into the Begaa Valley.

Gush Etzion: Four Wounded in Car Terror Attack

Attack occurred outside Alon Shvut, south of Jerusalem, at same bus stop from where 3 teens abducted last year; attacker arrested.

Four teenage boys have been wounded after being run over by a Palestinian Arab motorist in a car terror attack, at the entrance to the town of Alon Shvut in Gush Etzion, south of Jerusalem.

Three of the victims - all 16-year-old students - are all described in light to moderate condition: the fourth is in serious condition.

Magen David Adom (MDA) paramedics arrived on the scene and evacuated them to the Shaare Tzedek and Hadassah Medical Centers in the capital.

MDA paramedics Yoni Silman and Abba Richman relayed the scene: "When we got there, we saw at the junction on the side of the road, near a bus stop, three boys of about 16 lying on the ground. They were fully conscious and suffering injuries mainly to the face, the pelvic region, and the lower extremities."

"We gave them emergency first aid and with the help of IDF forces who arrived on the scene we evacuated them to Shaare Tzedek Medical Center and Hadassah Medical Center. One was in moderate condition; the other two light to moderate. They were apparently studying in the area and were on their way home."

The Palestinian driver fled the scene immediately after committing the attack, but was detained by security forces shortly after. A resident of Hevron (Hebron), he is now being interrogated by the Israel Security Agency.

Alon Shvut Junction is the site from which three Israeli teens - Eyal Yifrah, Gilad Sha'er and Naftali Frenkel - were kidnapped and ultimately murdered by Hamas terrorists last summer.

The use of cars and other vehicles as deadly weapons by "lone wolf" Palestinian terrorists has become increasingly frequent over the past year, with several Israelis murdered and dozens injured in a string of similar "car terror" incidents.

Palestinian official rules out negotiations without deadline for Israeli surrender.

PLO official Wasal Abu Yousef declared on Thursday that the Palestinians would not re-enter negotiations with Israel unless there is an established deadline for the end of what he called the Israeli "occupation of Palestine" adding that due to Washington's "bias" towards Israel "Bilateral negotiations under US auspices are no longer possible" and furthermore "We believe that the political horizon is completely closed with this new settler government." Meanwhile, US President Barak Obama declared this week in an interview with the London-based Asharq al-Awsat newspaper that he has not given up hope for a two-state solution to the Israel-Palestinian conflict but added "It's no secret that we now have a very difficult (6)



path forward. As a result, the United States is taking a hard look at our approach to the conflict. We look to the new Israeli government and the Palestinians to demonstrate - through policies and actions - a genuine commitment to a two-state solution."

'Demographic War With the Jews'

Some 6.1 million Palestinian Arabs live between the Mediterranean Sea and the Jordan River, 100,000 less than the number of Jews who live in the same area. That according to figures published this week by the Palestinian Bureau of Statistics in honor of "Nakba Day" - the commemoration of the "disaster" of Israel's rebirth on May 14, 1948.

For years various Israeli experts, like Prof. Arnon Sofer, have warned that the Palestinian population is growing more rapidly than the Jewish, while others say this demographic threat is a myth facilitated by the ludicrous reliance on statistics provided by the Palestinian Authority.

Whatever the case, the demographic issue is taken seriously, and is therefore having an impact on the way Israel conducts the peace process, and the Palestinian leadership knows it.

According to the figures published by Ramallah, there are some 12.1 million Palestinians worldwide, 2.8 million of whom live in Judea and Samaria (the West Bank) with another 1.8 million residing in Gaza. By comparison, the global Jewish population is 14.3 million with 6.2 million of them living in Israel.

If these numbers are accurate (and there is reason to take them with a grain of salt), Palestinian women indeed are giving birth to more children than their Jewish counterparts.

The Palestinian Bureau of Statistics optimistically estimates that the number of Palestinian Arabs in the region will grow by a full one million by 2020, thereby easily outnumbering Jews west of the Jordan River. A similar report published three years ago reported one million less Palestinians than today. In other words, according to the Palestinian leadership, the Palestinian population west of the Jordan River grows by at least one million people every three-to-five years.

For years, both sides have considered natural growth by the other to be a demographic threat. For this reason, the Palestinians are opposed to Jewish immigration to the Land of Israel, which at times has drastically increased Jewish population.

Should they succeed in establishing an independent state, many Palestinian politicians have expressed a desire to emulate the Jewish model and bring as many "Palestinians" from abroad inside their borders. And while many of these Arabs living abroad have no interest in joining a Palestinian state, if even one million answered the call, it would be enough to significantly impact the situation.

Years ago Gaza-based Hamas leader Ismail Haniya stated that his people are engaged in a demographic war with the Jews, and expressed confidence that on this front "we will defeat the Zionists."
