In absurd finding, UNHRC report dubs terror tunnels 'legitimate'

U.N. Human Rights Council report on Operation Protective Edge finds Hamas threats to fire rockets on Israeli cities constituted sufficient warning to residents • Terror tunnels under Gaza Strip-Israel border meant to target "only" IDF forces, it says.

Much like previous U.N. inquiries into Israeli military campaigns in the Gaza Strip, the U.N. Human Rights Council report into Operation Protective Edge, which was released Monday, featured harsh accusations against Israel alongside several absurd findings.

The report concluded, for example, that Hamas' threats to fire rockets on Israel constituted sufficient warning to the residents of central Israel, as well as to authorities running Ben-Gurion International Airport.

While the report stated that such "warnings" did not make the residents of Tel Aviv or foreign airlines into legitimate targets, "unlike in Gaza, Israelis could find shelter and had Iron Dome" to protect them.

Another puzzling finding concerned the grid of terror tunnels under the Gaza Strip. According to the fact-finding mission, during the "investigated period of time" the use of the tunnels meant to target "only" military forces, and not civilians.

The report also suggests that Israeli forces on the ground might have used human shields, saying the mission was unable to fully determine whether such action was taken, because it did not have free access to interview Gazans.

"The extent of the devastation and human suffering in Gaza was unprecedented and will impact generations to come," Justice Mary McGowan Davis, who headed the mission, told reporters in Geneva Monday.

The report made a favorable mention of the various steps employed by Israel to warn civilians in the Gaza Strip ahead of military strikes, saying its alert procedures have undoubtedly spared many lives, but faulting Israel for cases when Gazans failed to understand the warnings and get to safety.

The report further criticized Hamas, saying its use of inaccurate weapons "increases suspicion that it meant to harm and terrorize [Israeli] civilians."

The mission further said it suspects Hamas encouraged Gazans to ignore the IDF's warnings to evacuate, and said Hamas' execution of 21 people suspected of collaborating with Israel constituted a war crime.

Launcher Used to Attack Israel destroyed by IAF

Another rocket was launched at Israel at about 10pm Tuesday night landing in an open area near Askelon. IAF struck the launcher, destroying it, within a couple of hours.



Politicians and council heads across the spectrum condemned the

ongoing "trickle" of rocket fire at Israel's southern communities. An IDF spokesperson said that Israel considers the Hamas terrorist group responsible for any rocket attacks from Gaza. Hamas has been attempting to curb the latest firing of rockets into Israel claiming that the current rockets are "against the interests of the Palestinian people."

This follows an irregular firing of rockets at Israel claimed by the Salafist "Omar Brigades" group in the Gaza Strip who are sympathetic to the Islamic State group. A senior Salafist leader in Gaza said his people could not tolerate the reality of Hamas persecuting, arresting, and killing them. He added that the militants intended to continue firing rockets at Israeli targets, but claimed the intention was to trigger a civil war with Hamas and not to drag the Palestinians into another conflict with Israel.

Israel Rescinds Entry Permits For Gazans

The IDF announced on Wednesday it is rescinding 500 permits for Palestinians to enter Israel from the Hamas-ruled Gaza Strip following a rocket attack from the Strip the day before. The permits, allowing Moslems from the Strip to pray at the al-Aksa Mosque in Jerusalem during the Moslem holy month of Ramadan, were meant as a goodwill gesture. But Tuesday's rocket, which landed near the border community of Kibbutz Yad Mordechai, prompted IDF Maj.-Gen. Yoav Mordechai to tell the Palestinian Maan news agency that "Hamas is responsible for depriving worshipers of prayer in al-Aksa Mosque during Ramadan. I am not saying that Hamas fired the missile, but Hamas is responsible because it controls the Gaza Strip." In related news, a small flotilla of boats is on its way to the Strip, with the stated intention to run the blockade there and the expectation that they will approach Gaza later this week.

Yet Another Flotilla On Its Way To The Gaza Strip

Yet another flotilla is being organized by international anti-Israel networks to attempt running the blockade of the Hamas-ruled Gaza Strip, centered on a Swedish fishing vessel called the Marianne av Göteborg. Israeli-Arab MK Basel Ghattas told The Jerusalem Post on Sunday that he plans to join the flotilla, declaring that the protesters have "no violent intentions" but adding "If the IDF wants to kill, then shoot!" Deputy Foreign Minister Tzipi Hotovely characterized Ghattas's announcement as an example of "serving the enemy with parliamentary immunity." She added that the flotillas are totally unnecessary since Israel sends dozens of truckloads worth of supplies into Gaza every day and that "Flotillas like the one making its way to Israel are the handiwork of provocateurs who only want to make Israel look bad."

The opposition Zionist Union faction agreed, saying "Just as the flotilla to Gaza is not humanitarian, rather it is a political act to legitimize the Hamas regime and bring terrorism to Israel, so too MK Ghattas's participation is unfortunate and not humanitarian, but political and will bring conflict and quarrels within Israel." Yisrael Beytenu chairman Avigdor Liberman said, "Ghattas's planned participation in the flotilla is further proof that the Joint List is one big terrorist



vessel, which is only meant to harm the State of Israel and use Israeli democracy to try to destroy it.”

Chorus Of Condemnation Follows ‘lynching’ In Druze Village

Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu led a chorus of condemnation Monday following an attack on an IDF ambulance by Druze residents of the village of Majdal Shams in the Golan Heights. A wounded Syrian who was being transported in the ambulance and who the Druze villagers apparently believed was a fighter for a jihadist group opposed to the regime of Syrian President Bashar Assad, was killed in the attack. Another wounded Syrian was badly hurt by the mob, and the ambulance driver and another soldier were lightly injured. “Nobody can take the law into their own hands, and nobody can disrupt the missions of IDF soldiers,” Netanyahu declared. His remarks were echoed by several other senior officials as well as an IDF officer on the scene, who said “I must stress that the rumors circulating about us providing assistance to the Nusra Front are not true. We are strictly engaged in humanitarian aid.”

“Israel is a state of law, and we will not allow anarchy, violent conduct, and the taking of the law into one's own hand by a minority of its residents,” added Defense Minister Moshe “Bogie” Ya’alon. “This incident is a violation of the state's values, which are expressed by humanitarian medical treatment to injured Syrians, and to every person who needs it...the reality in Syria is complex. We are dealing with the situation responsibly, with sound judgement, and we are updating the Druze leadership of developments.”

“The IDF does not assist the Jabhat Al-Nusra organization since the start of internal [Syrian] fighting throughout the last four years,” added IDF Spokesman Brig-Gen. Moti Almoz in a post on his Facebook page. “We assist injured Syrians who arrive at the border and provide them with medical care. Now is the time to calm things down. I wish a speedy recovery to all of the injured.” In remarks to Army Radio, he went even further, describing the attack as “a lynching.”

Druze community leaders in Israel also condemned the attack and appealed for calm. The remarks were partially in response to a rumor which has taken hold in recent weeks among Israel’s Druze community that Israel is assisting jihadi groups fighting against the Assad regime despite the threat they pose to Druze communities in Syria.

Several People Arrested For Attack On IDF Ambulance

Israeli police arrested several individuals overnight Tuesday on suspicion that they were involved in Monday’s attacks on two IDF ambulances near the Druze village of Majdel Shams.

In related news, Israeli Druze community leaders have accused Samir Kuntar, the Lebanese Druze terrorist who spent 29 years in an Israeli prison for murdering Israeli children before being released in a prisoner swap with Hezbollah in 2008, for inciting Druze against Israel.



“The man who is behind the incident that is fuelling the violent events here is Samir Kuntar,” said Jabber Hamud, the head of the Sagur regional council who also serves as the chairman of the Druse and Circassian local councils. “We’ve known this for some time, and I call on the heads of the defense establishment to do all that is necessary.”

“The State of Israel is a country of laws, and everyone who breaks the law must be put on trial,” added Salman Amar, the head of the Julis regional council. “I call on the Israel Police not to hesitate in bringing the criminals to justice. Whoever attacks an IDF vehicle is a terrorist, and the attack was a terrorist act. Whoever raises a hand to an IDF soldier must have that hand cut off, whether it is an extremist Druse, a Jewish fanatic, or a nationalist Arab. I will be a bitter enemy of whoever attacks the IDF, and it doesn’t matter what the excuse is.”

ISIS Fighter Who 'Enjoyed' Killing Christians Repents. Wants to Follow Yeshua After Dream

It has become a common occurrence over the years for Muslims in the Middle East who have converted to Christianity to claim to have been compelled to do so after dreaming of a person who they believe is Jesus Christ.

Now, one militant belonging to the brutal Islamic State that has massacred Christians has converted to his victims' religion after dreaming of "a man in white" with a startling message, according to one missionary's account.

"One of our YWAM workers in the Middle East was contacted by a friend earlier this year and they met up and he was introduced to an ISIS fighter who had killed many Christians already. I mean that's a horrible situation, and admittedly, he was probably on guard," Gina Fadely, director of Youth With A Mission Frontier Missions, Inc. (YWAM), said during a recent appearance on The Voice of the Martyrs Radio Network.

YWAM, a nonprofit missionary organization active since 1960, describes itself as "a global movement of Christians from many cultures, age groups, and Christian traditions, dedicated to serving Jesus throughout the world.

Fadely, who appeared on the VOM radio program along with Kevin Sutter, another YWAM leader, went on to share that this Islamic State jihadi confessed not only to killing Christians but "that he had actually enjoyed doing so."

"He told this YWAM leader that he had begun having dreams of this man in white who came to him and said, 'You are killing my people.' And he started to feel really sick and uneasy about what he was doing,"

Fadely continued. "The fighter said just before he killed one Christian, the man said, 'I know you will kill me, but I give to you my Bible.' The Christian was killed and this ISIS fighter actually took the Bible and began to read it. In another dream, Yeshua asked him to follow him and he was now asking to become a follower of Christ and to be disciplined."

"So who knows. Perhaps this man will be like Saul in the Bible that persecuted Christians and he turned from that persecution of the early church to become the Apostle Paul who led it," Fadely added. "God can turn it around."
