Arabs Have Mixed Reaction To JCPOA (Iran Deal)

Analysts weigh in on risks and highlights. Leaders and citizens of Arab countries took to the airwaves, the internet and the streets this week to speak out about the Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action (JCPOA) announced on Tuesday regarding Iran's renegade nuclear program. Editorials in various Arab-language news outlets angrily denounced what was described as a Western betrayal of Arab and Sunni interests in the Middle East in favor of Iranian and Shi'ite interests. Also, Arab diplomats quietly and sometimes loudly echoed Israeli concerns about the infusion of cash Iran could soon receive which would aid it in its support for various terrorist organizations and militias in the region which are battling Sunni opponents. "This agreement, from our point of view, represents an indirect threat to Gulf and Arab interests and peace," said Tariq Al Shammari, a senior analyst from Saudi Arabia.

"Deal or no deal, tension in the region is not going to go away," added Abdulkhaleq Abdullah, a professor of political science at United Arab Emirates University. "If Iran is bent on acting as a hegemon, as a regional power, I think we are in for some difficult times."

A prominent Saudi cleric, Salman AL Ouda, tweeted Wednesday that "Iran is moving according to a well-studied clear vision, absorbing its adversaries. Where are the Arab governments? Where is their alternative project to face the challenge?"

However, some officials from Gulf countries tried to strike a more balanced tone, with leaders from the UAE and Kuwait even sending notes of congratulations to Teheran along with hopes that the deal could lead to greater stability in the region. Also, Arab League chief Nabil Al Arabi offered cautious support for the JCPOA Wednesday, adding that "It's time for the international community... to stop its policy of double standards and to undertake its responsibilities by pressuring Israel to join the non-proliferation agreement as a non-nuclear state."

Israel: Inspection Mechanism of Iran's Nuclear Sites "Worse than Worthless"

One of the main points of the nuclear agreement being hailed by Western powers as a victory is "worse than worthless," a senior Israeli minister stated on Wednesday.

In a briefing in Jerusalem, the National Infrastructure, Energy and Water Minister Yuval Steinitz slammed the mechanism in place that gives Iran a 24 day advanced notice of inspections to its nuclear program.

"Actually, you have here a mechanism that instead of serving the inspection is serving the deception," Steinitz stated.

According to the nuclear deal, Iran will have the ability to conceal any illicit nuclear activity before opening up its nuclear sites to inspectors. Steinitz charged that the advanced notice renders inspections, and therefore the agreement, useless.

Steinitz, a member of Israel's security cabinet, is Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu's unofficial point person on the Iran deal. While Israel is



satisfied with surveillance measures to be put in place at uranium enrichment facilities Fordo and Natanz, the minister said inspections at top-secret Iranian military sites will not keep Iran in check.

“Unfortunately, when you examine the details, you discover that the inspection [mechanism for undeclared military sites] is actually just a mirage,” he said.

Should intelligence agencies produce evidence that Iran was violating the agreement, inspectors would be powerless to conduct surprise visits. Rather, according to Steinitz, inspectors will need to “provide Iran the basis for such concerns and request clarification.”

“This is not just a worthless inspection method — it serves the Iranians. It’s backfiring. It’s counterproductive. It’s better to have an agreement without it,” Steinitz said.

With Israel, Saudi Arabia and Gulf states vehemently opposed to the nuclear agreement, Steinitz called Western powers “naïve” in signing a deal with the world’s largest sponsor of international terrorism.

“Israel is like the little child that is pointing its finger and saying, ‘The king is naked, this agreement is naked,’” Steinitz said. “Those who think that giving Iran \$150 billion will have no effect on the Middle East are naive,” he added. “It’s like pouring fuel on the burning Middle East.”

Echoing Steinitz’s comments, Netanyahu called the inspection mechanism “absurd.” During a speech to the Knesset, the prime minister states “It’s like giving a criminal organization that deals drugs a 24-day warning before inspecting its drug lab.”

“The agreement also requires the world powers to do something else — they must show Iran the very intelligence for which they want to conduct the inspections in the first place.”

President Obama Begins Selling The Iran Nuclear Agreement

US President Barak Obama wasted no time Tuesday evening in defending the agreement announced earlier in the day regarding Iran’s renegade nuclear program. In an interview with New York Times columnist Thomas Friedman Obama dismissed objections to the deal and predicted the failure of efforts to block its implementation in the US Congress. “Prime Minister Netanyahu would prefer, and many of the critics would prefer, that [Iran] doesn’t even have any nuclear capacity,” Obama said. “But really, what that involves is eliminating the presence of knowledge inside of Iran. Nuclear technology is not that complicated today, and so the notion that the yardstick for success was now whether they ever had the capacity possibly to obtain nuclear weapons — that can’t be the yardstick. The question is, do we have the kind of inspection regime and safeguards and international consensus whereby it’s not worth it for them to do it? We have accomplished that.”

“[P]erhaps [Netanyahu] thinks he can further influence the congressional debate, and I’m confident we’re going to be able to uphold this deal and implement it without Congress preventing that,” Obama continued. “But after that’s done, if that’s what he thinks is appropriate, then I will sit down, as we



have consistently throughout my administration, and then ask some very practical questions: How do we prevent Hezbollah from acquiring more sophisticated weapons? How do we build on the success of Iron Dome, which the United States worked with Israel to develop and has saved Israeli lives?”

Netanyahu launches PR campaign in the US

Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu launched a media campaign in the US on Wednesday, aimed at encouraging US citizens to contact their elected officials and lobby against the deal announced on Tuesday regarding Iran’s renegade nuclear program. Netanyahu said of the Iranian regime in an interview on CBS, “They decided that they want to wipe Israel off the map,... If somebody says, ‘I’m going to destroy you,’ you know, what you want to do is make sure they can’t.” He also gave interview to ABC, NBC and National Public Radio, expressing similar sentiments.

Gaza-based Terrorists Launch Rocket At Israel

Terrorists in the Hamas-ruled Gaza Strip fired a rocket into southern Israel Thursday morning, prompting retaliatory strikes by the Israeli Air Force on terror infrastructure. No casualties were reported by either side. In related news, Israeli security announced on Wednesday that they have arrested five suspects for alleged involvement in the killing of 25-year-old Danny Gonen and wounding his friend in a shooting attack near the West Bank community of Dolev on 19 June. Meanwhile, a female Palestinian terrorist stabbed an IDF soldier in the back near the community of Nahliel on Wednesday. The soldier was reported in stable condition with light-to-moderate wounds and his attacker was taken into custody. Elsewhere, diplomats were meeting in Jordan this week to assess what steps need to be taken to advance peace between Israel and the Palestinians.

Shin Bet Captures Five Terrorists Behind June Terror Murder

Wednesday, the Israeli Security Agency (ISA), also known as Shin Bet, confirmed the capture of the terrorists behind the murder of Danny Gonen on June, including the shooter himself.

According to the ISA statement, following a joint operation with elite IDF units and special police forces, they located and arrested several Palestinian Fatah members linked to last month’s shooting of Gonen and his friend. On Friday, June 19, the two young civilians were driving back from a hiking trip when a Palestinian man pulled them over, pretending to be in distress before opening fire on them, killing Gonen and injuring his friend.

The five terrorists confirmed by the Shin Bet are Muhammed Abu Shaheen, Force 17 fighter, Gonen’s shooter; Asraf Amar PA Military



Intelligence, accomplice; Amjad Aduan, Fatah member, lookout and ammo supplier; Muhammed Aduan, unaffiliated, hid the guns and ammo; Osama Assad, Fatah member, accomplice. Following the attack, a joint covert investigative and operational effort resulted in the arrest of several suspects from the vicinity of the Palestinian city of Ramallah. Suspects apprehended confessed to have been involved in several terrorist attacks including Gonen's shooting.

Additionally, illegal arms which include the gun used in the shooting were found, linking the suspects directly to the event. The shooter, Muhammed Abu Shaheen, 29, is a member of an elite Fatah security unit, Force 17, and receives a regular salary from the Palestinian Authority (PA). Abu Shaheen admitted to the shooting and several other terrorist attacks in the past. According to the ISA, the other arrestees, save for one, are all affiliated to Fatah, the largest faction in the Palestinian Authority.

IAF's New Fighter Pilot Helmet Takes Cue from Iron Man

The next phase of technology is coming to a fighter pilot near you, and coming on fast. Israeli defense firm Elbit Systems has launched a new state of the art helmet for IAF fighter pilots complete with their futuristic Canary program, a physiological monitoring device.

For many years, Elbit Systems has been at the forefront of technological advancement for the protection of soldiers and civilians in Israel, as well as international markets.

The new design takes its inspiration from Marvel superhero Iron Man, rather than DC's Black Canary, in spite of its name. The helmet, in a "Jarvis-like" style, will help monitor the health of the pilots and issue real-time alerts for life threatening inflight situations, such as losing consciousness or lack of oxygen.

"Pilots may be exposed to life-threatening medical conditions during flight due to low levels of oxygen," said Elbit Systems Aerospace Division's General Manager, Yoram Shmuely, in a statement.

"Modern aircraft may cause G-induced Loss of Consciousness (GLOC) and other physiological conditions (such as extreme fatigue, dehydration, etc.) which are a common cause for accidents with no reliable warning or recovery solution available," added Shmuely. "We believe that our new system will solve these problems and save pilots' lives."

Canary will be integrated with the pilot's helmet and Helmet Mounted Display (HMD), or the plane's mission computer via the HMD interface. Canary will give warnings regarding life threatening situations such as lack of oxygen better known as hypoxia, or a loss of consciousness, thus garnering its name from the canaries used by miners to determine which mine shaft contained bad air.

The Canary program even has the ability to take over control of the plane and place it on autopilot should the pilot be rendered incapable of flying due to physiological issues. The integrated monitoring device can speed the pilots to safety, should they lose the ability to do so themselves, just as the computer program 'Jarvis' does for Iron Man time and again.
