Outrageous: Abbas hosts family members of terrorists

Palestinian Authority (PA) chairman Mahmoud Abbas, who the West often claims is a "peace partner" for Israel, on Wednesday night hosted families of terrorists from Jerusalem, some of whom carried out deadly attacks against Jews.

The meeting, which took place at Abbas's headquarters in Ramallah, was held just hours after three Palestinian Arab terrorists carried out a shooting and stabbing attack at the Damascus Gate in Jerusalem, killing one Border Police officer, Hadar Cohen, and wounding a second one.

In attendance at the meeting were family members of 11 terrorists who carried out attacks during the last four months and whose bodies are still being held by Israel.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss ways to return the bodies of the terrorists to their families. Abbas told the families that he is making great efforts to have the bodies returned and claimed that the burial of "shahids" (martyrs) is a right and as such he is opposed to the conditions set by Israel for the release of the bodies.

The meeting was attended among others by the family of Baha Alian, one of two terrorists who carried out a shooting and stabbing attack on a bus in the Armon Hanatziv neighborhood in Jerusalem which killed three people.

Also in attendance were family members of terrorist Ala Abu Jamal, an employee of Bezeq who ran over civilians standing at a bus stop in the capital city's Malchei Yisrael Street just minutes after the Armon Hanatziv attack. He then got out of the car and proceeded to stab others nearby.

The fact that Abbas met with families of terrorists should come as no surprise, as he has refused to condemn attacks against Israelis and, in fact, has justified the attacks by claiming that Palestinians are driven to carry them out due to their frustration with the "difficult conditions" under which they live.

Abbas, officials who are close to him and PA media have all been responsible for much of the incitement to terrorism against Israelis.

One example of Abbas's incitement is his infamous call on Palestinian

Arabs to "liberate" the Al-Aqsa Mosque in Jerusalem from Jews and their "filthy feet". He also was revealed to have made shocking statements on Palestinian TV, where he publicly stated that the murder of dozens of Israelis and the wounding of hundreds others is part of a "peaceful uprising."

'Hadar acted with courage and determination'

Details emerge of Border Police officer's heroic actions in preventing attack of much worse scale in heart of Jerusalem.

As the investigation into the deadly shooting and stabbing near Jerusalem's Damascus Gate on Wednesday continues, a fuller picture has emerged of the Border Police officers' heroism in preventing a worse attack.

A team of four police officers, two men and two women, spotted two Arabs sitting on a bench. When they approached and demanded to see their identity cards, one opened fire while the other rushed at the police officers with a knife.

Hadar Cohen managed to kill one of the terrorists, before a third attacker came and shot her in the head, critically wounding her. She died several hours later at Hadassah Mount Scopus hospital from wounds sustained in the attack.

The second female police officer injured in the attack also managed to fend off one of the terrorists, wrestling with him despite stab wounds all over her body. Initially seriously injured, her condition has improved and is now listed as moderate.

As stated, Cohen managed to kill one terrorist while the second was shot dead by another Border Police officer at the scene. The third terrorist, who attacked Cohen from behind, was eliminated by a police officer who arrived later.

Chief Superintendent Shlomi Yosef, the commander of Cohen's Border Police unit, praised her "heroic and determined actions in cocking her weapon and eliminating the terrorist," before expressing his sorrow at her death.

He also offered a speedy recovery to the second female officer injured in the attack, currently being hospitalized in Jerusalem.

Responding to questions over why officers with little experience were deployed to a known problematic area, Yosef clarified, "They were positioned there with a veteran leader, an officer who knows the sector and they are skilled and trained for these situations."

"They responded with courage and determination," he stressed.

Hamas: The "Merchants of War" Who Seek to Destroy Israel

In the words of Hamas leader Ismail Haniyeh, the tunnels are being dug not only to "defend the Gaza Strip, but to serve as a launching pad to reach all of Palestine." As one can see from any map of Palestine, "all of Palestine" does not mean living in peace alongside Israel; it means supplanting Israel.

To its credit, Hamas has been refreshingly transparent about its ambition, the elimination of Israel. Hamas wants the Palestinians to continue living in



misery and bitterness. It is fertile soil for jihad recruitment.

A Palestinian Authority-Hamas unity government would mean tunnels not only along the border between the Gaza Strip and Israel, but also from the West Bank into Israel.

Forever looming, of course, is the illusion that Abbas will be able to persuade Hamas to abandon its aim to destroy Israel.

The myth that Hamas uses tunnels to smuggle food and other necessities to the "besieged" Gaza Strip has been buried under the rubble of the tunnel that collapsed last week east of Gaza City.

The incident, in which seven members of Hamas's armed wing, Ezaddin Al-Qassam, were killed when the tunnel they were working in collapsed, provides further proof that the Islamist movement has stayed true to its charter, which calls for the total destruction of Israel.

The Hamas men who were killed in the tunnel collapse belonged to the movement's elite "Tunnel Unit." According to Ezaddin Al-Qassam, the men were busy repairing one of the tunnels (damaged during the 2014 war with Israel) when it collapsed due to severe weather conditions.

'Was Israel involved in tunnel collapses? God knows'

IDF's Yoav Mordechai evades question when asked by PA news agency if Israel is responsible for collapse of Hamas's tunnels.

Major General Yoav Mordechai, the Coordinator of Government Activities in the Territories (COGAT), on Wednesday night gave an interview to the Palestinian Arab Ma'an news agency, in which he discussed Hamas's terror tunnels.

The interview took place in the wake of the recent collapses of several of Hamas's tunnels. On Wednesday night, a tunnel collapsed in the Zeitoun neighborhood - the third time a tunnel collapsed in a week and the second time in as many days.

During the interview, Mordechai warned that Hamas's digging of tunnels leading into Israel will bring death and destruction to Gaza and its population, but said the tunnels do not pose a strategic threat to Israel.

Hamas, Mordechai told Ma'an, is building "tunnels of death" at the expense of Gaza's residents by taking construction materials that enter Gaza and using them to build tunnels instead of rebuilding damaged homes.

He also noted that during the past year and a half, Israel has allowed the entry of 3.5 million tons of construction materials into Gaza through the Kerem Shalom crossing. Israel continues to transfer humanitarian aid, goods and construction materials into Gaza, despite constant claims by Hamas that it is imposing a "siege" on the region.

Mordechai suggested that Gazans stay away from the tunnels "especially after what happened a few days ago after the collapse of a tunnel."

He was then asked whether Israel had a hand in the collapse of the tunnels, a question which he evaded and only answered with, "God knows."

Hamas has been working hard to rebuild its network of tunnels -

including attack tunnels into Israel and smuggling tunnels to and from Egypt - which were largely destroyed during the 2014 Operation Protective Edge.

Following last week's tunnel collapse, Hamas deputy leader Ismail Haniyeh finally publicly confirmed what had been well-known for a long time, that the group is rebuilding its tunnel infrastructure.

Israel considering revoking permits to terrorists' relatives

Netanyahu orders to look into new measures against terrorism following deadly attack at Damascus Gate.

Israel will consider new measures against terrorism, it was decided on Wednesday evening at a security discussion led by Prime Minister Binyamin Netanyahu, following the deadly shooting and stabbing attack at Jerusalem's Damascus Gate earlier in the day.

Among the measures Netanyahu is considering is the revocation of work permits in Israel to families of terrorists.

Meanwhile, at the same discussion it was decided that the IDF would impose a closure on Kabatiyah in northern Samaria - the Palestinian town from which the three Arab terrorists arrived. Border Police officer Hadar Cohen, 19, of Or Yehuda was killed in the attack Wednesday, making her the 31st victim in the ongoing terror wave. She is survived by her parents, a brother and a sister. Another Border Police officer was wounded in the attack and was taken to hospital, where her condition later improved. On Wednesday evening she was visited by police chief Roni Alsheich, who commended her for efforts which prevented a bigger attack.

Two seriously injured in Jerusalem shooting attack

In another incident three terrorists armed with sub-machine guns, knives and bombs open fire on Border Police near Jerusalem's Damascus Gate. Two female border police officers aged 19 and 20 were seriously wounded in the shooting attack.

Both officers were evacuated to Jerusalem's Hadassah Mount Scopus hospital. One of the casualties is in critical condition and on a respirator, while the condition of the second victim has stabilized somewhat and classified as moderate-to-serious.

According to initial reports, three Arab terrorists armed with concealed Carl Gustav sub-machine guns, knives and bombs were spotted acting suspiciously by Border Police officers close to Damascus Gate. When officers approached, one of the terrorists produced his ID, and another suddenly opened fire, wounding two officers. Other officers in the vicinity returned fire, eliminating all three. The terrorists have been identified as Palestinian Arabs from the Jenin area in Samaria. It is the second attack this week, following Sunday's shooting attack between Bet El and Ramallah, just north of Jerusalem. Several other attacks have also been thwarted this week by alert police officers, including several planned stabbing attacks.
