U.S. DEDICATES JERUSALEM EMBASSY IN HISTORIC EVENT Australian Prayer Network.

After 22 of years waiting for a president to move the US embassy in Israel from Tel Aviv to Jerusalem, it has finally happened. President Donald Trump made good on one of his key campaign promises, to the delight of both Israeli Jews and evangelical Christians around the world. The historic move recognizes Jerusalem as the true capital of the Jewish state. It happened 70 years to the day that Israel proclaimed its independence, fighting to re-establish a homeland for the Jewish people. In his welcoming remarks at the embassy's official dedication ceremony, US Ambassador to Israel David Friedman praised Trump for his bold decision.

"Today's historic event is attributed to the vision, the courage, and the moral clarity of one person to whom we owe an enormous and eternal debt of gratitude, President Donald J. Trump," Friedman said. Trump's son-in-law Jared Kushner also spoke in a rare public appearance. "We believe it is possible for both sides to gain more than they give so that all people can live in peace, safe from danger, free from fear, and able to pursue their dreams," Kushner said of the Israelis and Palestinians. He also condemned the violent protests that broke out at the Gaza border in which dozens of people were killed.

"As we have seen from the protests of the last month, those provoking violence are part of the problem and not of the solution," Kushner said. Among the evangelical leaders at the ceremony were Pastor John Hagee, founder of Christians United for Israel, and Pastor Robert Jeffress who opened the ceremony with prayer. "We come before You, the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, thanking You for bringing us to this momentous occasion in the life of Your people and in the history of our world," said Jeffress. He and many evangelicals believe this move aligns with God's will and what the Bible says about Israel.

"I will bless those who bless you, and whoever curses you I will curse," God says to Abraham in Genesis 12:3. Jeffress and Hagee both thanked God for the leadership of Trump. "We thank you, O Lord, for President Donald Trump's courage in acknowledging to the world a truth that was established 3,000 years ago, that Jerusalem is and always shall be the eternal capital of the Jewish people," said Hagee. Hagee said Israel has become "the lone torch of freedom in the Middle East" because of God's "everlasting love for the Jewish people."

"Jerusalem is the city of God, Jerusalem is the heartbeat of Israel, Jerusalem is where Abraham placed his son on the altar," he continued. "Jerusalem is where Messiah will come and establish a kingdom that will never end." For those who "curse" Israel, Hagee had a clear message. "Let the word go forth from Jerusalem today that Israel lives. Let every Islamic terrorist hear this message: Israel lives! Let the word go forth today that Israel lives," Hagee said, "because He that keepeth Israel neither slumbers nor sleeps."

GAZAN KITES SPARK FIRES IN SOUTHERN ISRAEL, JEWISH NATIONAL FUND TO SUE HAMAS

KKL-JNF will sue Hamas for environmental damages. Incendiary kites launched from Gaza continued to ravage land in southern Israel on Tuesday, sparking fires in as many as 10 different locations.

Among those locations was a field opposite the Sapir College in the Sha'ar HaNegev Regional Council. The students carried on with their studies as usual at the college and firefighters extinguished the flames.

Various sites and communities in the Eshkol Regional Council and the Sha'ar Hanegev regional council were hit by the kites.

KKL-JNF staff and national firefighters managed to gain control over the fires. KKL-JNF said Tuesday that it intends to sue Hamas in international legal court for the severe environmental damages that were caused to KKL-JNF land in the area surrounding the Gaza border from rockets, mortar shells and incendiary kites launched from the enclave into Israel.

KKL-JNF World Chairman, Daniel Atar, who toured the affect southern areas with KKL-JNF Management, said, "It is inconceivable that the international community would allow Hamas not to be held accountable and pay for its criminal acts; not only against the citizens of the state of Israel, but also against nature and the environment which have been severely hurt by this criminal environmental terrorism. Hamas has proved that they have no humanity; not just toward human beings, but also toward animals and natural resources."

Since the start of the fire kite phenomenon, 265 fires have been recorded, in which approximately 697 acres of KKL-JNF forests have burned.

"We are going on a planting campaign with the children from the towns surrounding Gaza: Hamas burns forests – we plant them," Atar said. "We will prove that our lives here are founded on strength and growth."

Minister of Public Security Gilad Erdan toured the Kissufim area and said: "our brave firefighters can extinguish the fires, but only the IDF can eliminate those who lit them. I expect the IDF to carry out targeted assassinations of terrorist kite launchers that endanger people's lives on a daily basis. They need to know that they will pay for it."

MARKED INCREASE IN JEWS CONVERTING TO CHRISTIANITY

One of the world's oldest missionary organisations is celebrating its 175th anniversary this year. Christian Witness to Israel (CWI) focuses on trying to convert Jewish people to Christianity and is celebrating what it says is a 'marked increase in the number of Jewish people coming to faith'. CEO Joseph Steinberg said: 'Jewish people are not beyond the grasp of God's saving power. We are excited that Jewish people can love and embrace the Messiah who came to set them free. We want the Church to rediscover its confidence that Jesus saves, even Jewish people, and get behind our work so that the whole world may come to know God's saving power.'

The anniversary celebrates CWI's work in the past, including its 'House of Refuge' during the Holocaust as well as its present-day missionaries in Israel, France, Holland, Hungary, Bulgaria, the USA and the UK. A statement from the charity read: 'CWI are seeing a marked increase in the number of Jewish people coming to faith. Over the last two years CWI's international team of missionaries have reported 60 Jewish people coming to faith in Jesus, a significant increase over previous years.' The work of the charity is regarded as controversial in some quarters as some Christians believe it is inappropriate for Christians to attempt to convert Jews. Source: Christian Today

ISRAEL TO DEPORT 40,000 ILLEGAL IMMIGRANTS

Australian Prayer Network news. Israel's Knesset has overwhelmingly approved a bill empowering the government to bypass the Supreme Court and deport more than 40,000 illegal immigrants. The bill, approved by a 71-41 vote, will also close the illegal immigrant detention facility in the central town of Holon. Over the past decade, some 60,000 illegal immigrants have entered Israel, most of them via the southern border with Egypt. Most of the migrants come from north-eastern African countries like Eritrea, Sudan and Somalia. While some are legitimate refugees, most are economic migrants.

In 2012, Israel constructed an advanced border fence along its frontier with Egypt which drastically reduced the number of illegal immigrants entering the country. Simultaneously, the government tried to reduce the number of illegals in the country by offering them monetary incentives to return home. But many didn't take the offer, and the Supreme Court blocked the government from forcibly deporting them. The court also ruled that the government could only detain the illegals for up to 12 months, meaning

that those who could endure a full year of internment could then remain freely in Israel indefinitely.

North Korea: How Jews and Christians Survive In The World's Most Anti-Judeo-Christian Nations

From the late 19th century until the Korean War, North Korea was a Christian stronghold – and Pyongyang was considered the "Jerusalem of the East."

Fox News by Hollie McKay June 06. "Life is extremely difficult for all North Koreans, but Christians and the rare Jew face an even tougher road," Jeff King, president of International Christian Concern told Fox News.

While it is now anything but friendly to the faithful, activists claim Christianity is still burgeoning in the deeply tyrannical country. Despite efforts to eradicate Christians, the Church of Christ in North Korea is actually growing. They know only God is powerful enough to break through the darkness of the most oppressive regime on earth.

For 16 years, North Korea has been ranked the "most oppressive place in the world for Christians," and this week the U.S. State Department re-asserted it as one of the world's worst religious persecutors – torturing and executing those even suspected of worshipping God. But that still hasn't stopped an estimated 36 percent of the population – around 9 million – from practicing Christianity.

"Christians are accused of being imperialists seeking to overthrow the government and those who are caught practicing their faith are arrested, horrendously tortured, imprisoned and [sometimes] immediately put to death." So how do these brave devotees do it in the most closed country on earth? On the surface, Christianity does exist in North Korea. Its constitution on paper vows to protect religious freedom and forbids discrimination based on one's faith. Thus, the capital, Pyongyang, is currently host to five state-controlled churches - the Protestant Bongsu, Chilgol and Jeil Churches, the Catholic Jangchung Cathedral and the most recent being the Orthodox Holy Trinity Russian Church. Yet all are deemed to be little more than fraudulent showpieces for visiting officials and tourists. Foreign visitors are routinely paraded around these sites, in which aptly dressed church officials clutch Bibles and bow at the altar. But Chad O'Carroll, managing director of the Seoul-based news and analysis firm Korea Risk Group, told Fox News that these are generally just hand-picked state workers whose vocation is to feign religion. ...
