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### The Australian Family Association Requests We Act to protect our religious freedoms

Dear BGE Community,

The government response to the Ruddock Inquiry on protection of religious freedom is the be published before the end of the year. In the meantime, there has been no resolution of the matter of the protections for faith based schools. On the last sitting day of Federal Parliament for 2018 the Senate referred this matter to a Senate Committee for inquiry. It may be that protections for faith based schools may be dealt with as part of the wider religious freedom issue.

There have now been two ALP Bills, the Sex Discrimination Amendment (Removal of Discrimination Against Students) Bill 2018 (introduced by Senator Penny Wong in the Senate) https://tinyurl.com/yakllrcc and the similarly worded Sex Discrimination Amendment (Removal of Discrimination Against Students) Bill 2018 (No 2) (introduced into the House of Representatives by Bill Shorten) https://tinyurl.com/y9kukmqs which seek to remove from the Sex Discrimination Act (SDA) the

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provisions that protect the freedom of faith-based schools and educational institutions.

#### These Bills seek to:

- Add a new Section 37(3) to remove the protection in Section 37(1)(d) (which provides that "any ... act or practice of a body established for religious purposes, ... necessary to avoid injury to the religious susceptibilities of adherents of that religion" does not amount to discrimination) from any act or practice in relation to students connected to the provision of education by that body; and
- Repeal Section 38(3), which provides that an act done "in good faith" by "an educational institution ... conducted in accordance with the doctrines, tenets, beliefs or teachings of a particular religion or creed ... to avoid injury to the religious susceptibilities of the adherents of that religion or creed" does not mount to unlawful discrimination.

The Inquiry notified on this link https://tinyurl.com/y74yppn6 is to be held by the Senate Legal and Constitutional Affairs Legislation Committee into the ALP proposed Senate Bill. Submissions are due by 21 January, 2019 and the Committee is to report by 11 Feb,

Coalition amendments proposed to the ALP Bill would be an improvement but still fall short of the current protections (under Sections 37 and 38) of the SDA.

## Points you can adapt in your own words to make a Submission:

• Section 38(3) currently provides freedom for faith-based "educational institutions" to take into account in dealing with students matters such as sexual orientation and gender identity which would otherwise be unlawful. This provision recognises "the right to freedom of thought, conscience, and religion or belief" protected by the

International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights. Its repeal would remove the freedom of faith based schools to make decisions in relation to students where a student openly and publically opposes or acts contrary to the teachings or principles or values of the faith of the school. The repeal of Section 38(3) would remove any freedom for a faith based school to directly counsel. discipline or deal with a student who actively promoted a view of sexuality opposed to the view of the school.

- The repeal of Section 38(3) would also remove protection not only from faith based schools (primary and secondary) but from any faith based educational institutions which would include tertiary colleges or university or other institution where education is provided. It would have wide operation.
- Proposed new Section 37(3) would remove the freedom of faith based schools to set conditions and requirements or standards in relation to sexual orientation or gender identity to ensure compliance with the doctrines, tenets or beliefs of the religion of the school.

- Proposed new Section 37 (3) removes protections from faith based "educational institutions" but also from "all bodies established for religious purposes" - would this include churches themselves? - and mosques and synogogues? Would homilies in church or training of chaplains or youth group leaders or instruction to youth groups on issues of morality around sexual identity and sexual activity be considered "an act or practice ... connected with the provision ... of education" and therefore amount to discrimination even if it "conforms to the doctrines, tenets or beliefs ... or is necessary to avoid injury to the religious susceptibilities of the adherents of that religion"?
- Urge the Committee to recommend maintaining the present protections for faith based schools and educational institutions. No school would expel a student on the grounds of sexual orientation but faith based schools should be able to make decisions how to manage behaviour/activism opposed to the beliefs/values of the school.
- Removal of the current protections for faith based schools would mean they would not be able to

preserve the beliefs and values of the school so that parents' right to choose the education they want for their child that accords with their convictions would be denied. This would be contrary to Article 18.4 of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights which requires states signatories to the Covenant (which includes Australia) to "have respect for the liberty of parents ... to ensure the religious and moral education of their children in conformity with their own convictions."

I will have further updates when more information is to hand.

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# The Hamas Plan to Take the West Bank

- Hamas and its allies are openly working and encouraging the eruption of a new anti-Israel uprising in the West Bank, and they have been emboldened by the recent failure of the UN General Assembly to adopt a US-sponsored resolution condemning Hamas and other Palestinian groups for firing rockets at Israel and inciting violence.
- The Hamas-engineered attacks are not only a threat to Israeli civilians and soldiers; they also undermine the Western-funded Palestinian Authority (PA) of Mahmoud Abbas. Each "successful" attack carried out by Hamas earns it more popularity in the West Bank, at the cost of Abbas and his regime.
- Now that Hamas is getting what it wants in the Gaza Strip -- millions of dollars and no war with Israel -- it is seeking to shift the attention to the West Bank, all with the help of its friends in Tehran. This has a twofold goal: to undermine or overthrow the Palestinian Authority, inflict heavy casualties on Israel, and thwart any peace plan brought forward by the US administration.

It is clear by now that Hamas is behind some of the recent terror attacks against Israelis in the West Bank. These attacks serve the interests of Hamas and its friends and sponsors, especially the Palestinian Islamic Jihad organization -- and Iran.

Hamas and its allies have a plan, and they are not even keeping it a secret -to export their "armed struggle" against Israel beyond the Gaza Strip and ultimately to take control of the West Bank.

The latest terrorist attack took place on December 9 outside the West Bank settlement of Ofra, east of Ramallah. An Israeli-Canadian citizen, Amichai Ish-Ran, and this pregnant wife, Shira, were among seven people wounded in a drive-by shooting attack. The baby born prematurely as a result of the terrorist attack died on December 12, after doctors fought to save his life for close to 72 hours.
