## "Family March" held in Haifa ahead of Gay Pride Parade

With the wide-spread acceptance of alternative gender identity and relationships in western countries, those who hold to the Biblical model of marriage and family have been ridiculed and their voices stifled. Pride Parades have become annual celebrations on all continents during the month of June, with the Israeli cities of Tel-Aviv, Jerusalem, and Haifa each holding their own such events. Tel-Aviv is said to host the Middle East's largest parade, with approximately 250,000 participants in 2019.

This year, for the first time, secular and religious Israelis organized a countermarch in Haifa in support of traditional family values. The event focused on supporting conservative families; at no point was dislike expressed towards the LGBTQ community. Instead, it aimed to resist the "progressive" censorship experienced by those who don't support non-binary sexual identity and family structure becoming the social norm. Almost 1,000 adults and children participated, including members of 5 Messianic Jewish congregations, despite Facebook deleting the page that had been used to publicize the event.

One of the march's organizers was Attorney Na'ama Selah, who describes herself as decidedly secular. "The traditional family a society's cornerstone. Societies without traditional families go extinct," she said at the march. "Traditional families are disappearing in Europe and being replaced with strange hybrids. We don't want the same to happen to

"Identity politics dictate the way we speak. We are made to believe that we need to be careful about expressing certain beliefs." What worries her most is what is being taught to children in the Israeli school system, not unlike schools in North America and Europe: "The Ministry of Education puts [ambiguous sexuality and flexible family structure] in kindergartens. ## Our Lord Yeshua was from the family of King David and also high priest Zadok of Aaron

King Priest Yeshua is from the family of high priest Zadok of Aaron, ... a simplified explanation ... by Richard Aaron Honorof

## God verified this Truth in His Word with three totally separate biblical proofs!

Hebrews 8:1 Now this is the main point of the things we are saying. We have such a High Priest, who is seated at the right hand of the Throne of the Majesty in the Heavens,

Psalm 110:1 The LORD (Father) said to my Lord (His Son), "Sit at My right hand, till I make Your enemies Your footstool."110:4 The LORD has sworn and will not relent, "You are a Priest forever according to the order of Melchi Zedek"

The King and Great High Priest of Heaven, (Yeshua) Melchi Zedek, (my King of Righteousness) said "a body You have prepared for Me!"

This Hebrews 10:5 passage taken from Septuagint of Psalms 40:6;

We know that Yeshua's (God's Son's) <u>physical earthly body</u> that He would be born in on the earth would be fulfillment of the line of kings from king David. Therefore, since God always does all things perfectly, and being that He is also <u>the Great High Priest of Heaven</u>, Melchi Zedek, His <u>physical body</u> that was prepared for

Him was also the fulfillment of the highest order of the Aaronic high priest family of Yehoshua, of Zadok or 'righteous', of Aaron. Let's see where this is proven ...

Being that Yeshua had no earthly father, He could never have been an Aaronic priest, but He is always from the two families of His virgin mother Miriam; He was from both king David's family and also high priest Zadok's family of Aaron. Let's now look at these three proofs ...

1. The Seed from Eve (Genesis 3:15) that went to virgin Miriam would go to Abram, to Isaac, to Jacob, to Judah, to Amminadab, then to his son Nahshon (Numbers 1:4,7) & then on to king David. But this Seed also split. going to Amminadab's daughter Elisheva. Amminadab's daughter Elisheva married Moses' brother Aaron. (Exodus 6:23) Elisheva + Aaron had 4 sons. This Seed then went to priest Elieazar, to his son Pinchas ... and on to high priest Zadok. From high priest Zadok this Seed went to Miriam's mother, and from king David this Seed went to Miriam's father. Through intermarriage, this Seed went on into baby Miriam. The virgin Miriam + the Holy Spirit brought the conception of Yeshua, in winter, Kislev 24 (Haggai 2:18, 19). The only begotten Son of God was born nine months later on Succoth.

To also see this proven another way, God showed me many years ago that if you were to take three words, right, righteous, and righteousness, where they relate to a specific person in the bible, these people are mainly from

two families, king David's and priest Zadok's family. (Go to my website under Author's Articles to see this study.)

- 2. The angel Gabriel told Miriam that her Son Yeshua would Reign on the Throne of His father David; (Luke 1:32) through the geneology of Miriam's father. And also of her 'relative' Elisheva. (Luke 1:36) This word relative is from the Greek and means blood relative. So what family was Miriam and her mother? The same family as both of Miriam's relatives Elisheva of Aaron and priest Zechariah. But what family of Aaron were they both from? God had told us the answer in Luke 1:6. The family that was righteous before God. (also see it in Only one Aaronic priest Luke 1:75) family called Zadok could come before God. (See this in Ezekiel 43:18, 19 and Ezekiel 44:15, 16 ... the family of Zadok) And also Zadok means righteous. Zechariah and Elisheva and Miriam were all from this Zadokite Aaronic high priest family. And then Miriam spent the first three months of her pregnancy with her close blood kin relatives, pregnant Elisheva of Aaron and priest Zechariah.
- 3. The Hebrew word for 'the Branch' is <u>Tzemach</u>, is found in only five places in the prophesies of Messiah in the Old Testament (Tanakh). 'The Branch,' <u>Tzemach</u> is Yeshua, the King and Great High Priest!
- a) Isaiah 4:2 The Branch (Tzemach) of Jehovah is Yeshua.
- b) Jeremiah 23:5, 6 The LORD our Righteousness and the Branch (Tzemach) of Righteousness would be

from king David's family.

- c) Jeremiah 33:14-24 The LORD of Righteousness, and the Branch (Tzemach) of Righteousness would be the Man coming from king David's family in verse 17. But now God also says more, that He would also be the Man coming from Aaron's family, and who is also before God, verse 18. This qualification before God means that this Man had to also be from the Zadokite high priest family. Verse 24 talks of two families, David's and Aaron's family which God had chosen in order to bring forth God's Son to earth thru the virgin (Miriam). Isaiah 7:14
- d) Zechariah 3:1-9 The Messiah would also be <u>God's Servant</u>, Tzemach, coming from the high priest family of Yehoshua of high priest Zadok (verses 1, 8) [also see Zechariah 6:11] whose Blood alone removed the sin of the high priest (verse 4) and which also cleansed the land (verse 9). Only Messiah's Blood could cleanse the land. Tzemach is Yeshua, seen here as <u>the</u> Son of Man.
- e) Zechariah 6:11-13 The Messiah would be the Man Tzemach from the high priest family of Yehoshua of high priest Zadok, whose father is Jeho-Zadok. He (Tzemach) will build the Temple of the LORD (repeated twice), and He will also bear the Glory. Tzemach is Yeshua, who is seen here having returned to earth as the Son of God!
- 4) God also showed this mystery at the time of Yeshua's Conception.

Why did elderly Aaronic priest Zechariah and his pregnant old wife



Elisheva, whom God told us were righteous before God (Luke 1:5, 6) have ever allowed a virgin, this pregnant and only just betrothed young woman Miriam from the family of David and tribe of Judah, into their home, and for the next three months. The answer must be very obvious; they had to be Miriam's closest blood kin relatives. This had to be Miriam's closest family through her own mother. Priest Zechariah also must have known Isaiah's prophesies in Isaiah 7:14 about the virgin bearing a Son.

- 5) Why did God, through His angel Gabriel tell this Aaronic priest Zechariah that he had to name his son Yochanan, when his future son was yet un-conceived. Because God was keeping His promises given to the Zadokite high priest family in Zechariah 3:8 and Zechariah 6:12. Because Yochanan was the name of the last Zadokite high priest, around 165 B.C., just before the Maccabees threw out the Zadokite high priest and the rest of the Zadokite priest family, and then took over the Jerusalem Temple, corrupting the Temple's Aaronic priesthood until the Jerusalem Temple was destroyed by the Romans in 70 A.D. [See this in Art Scroll Publications, Yoma Edition, Volume 9: Kohen HaGadolim of the First and the Second Temple Periods.
- 6) Priest Zechariah and his son Yochanan were both God's last Zadokite high priests, while Herod had appointed two phony high priests to rule from the Jerusalem Temple, Annas and Caiaphas.

How can it be proven that they were from this family of Zadok, and also God's true high priests? First, only

a priest from the Aaronic priest family of Zadok was allowed to come into God's Presence, as Zechariah had through the angel Gabriel. see Ezekiel 43:18, 19 and Ezekiel 44:15, 16; Secondly, to minister at the position of the Altar of Incense (Luke 1:11) was the position God had given to Aaron the high priest, and also to his future sons who would serve Him as the future high priest at this special holy position in the Jerusalem Temple, i.e. at the Altar of Incense. See Exodus 30:1, 7

When God sent His angel Gabriel to speak with Zechariah, Gabriel had met him at the Altar of Incense. After 165 years of Temple priesthood corruption, Zechariah was shown to be the true mystery Zadokite high priest. Then Zechariah's future son would also have been the next mystery Zadokite high priest, being called by God to a most special ministry, to announce that the Kingdom of Heaven was coming to earth, and also to announce the Messiah, "the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world," at the Jordan River. John 1:29 Matthew 3:15 Yeshua said ... "Permit it to be so now, for thus it is fitting for us to fulfill all Righteouness." Matthew 21:32 And "Yochanan came to

you in the way of righteousness
"Matthew 11:7 Yeshua began to say to
the multitudes concerning John, ... 11:9
"But what did you go out to see? A
prophet? Yes, I say to you, and more
than a prophet." (Repeated also in Luke 7:26)
