## SUKKOTAIDO

#### 15-22 Tishri

#### FESTIVAL OF BOOTHS -TABERNACLES -

ADONAI said to Moshe, "Tell the people of

Isra'el, 'On the fifteenth day of this seventh month is the feast of Sukkot for seven days to Adonai. On the first day is to be a holy convocation; do not do any kind of ordinary work. For seven days you are to bring an offering made by fire to Adonai; on the eighth day you are to have a holy convocation and bring an offering made by fire to Adonai; it is a day of public assembly; do not do any kind of ordinary work. Vayikra-Leviticus 23:33-36

SUKKOT (15 Tishri) - The Festival of Tabernacles or Booths (Hebrew 'sukkot'). One of the three pilgrim festivals (the others being Passover and Shavuot) when, in ancient times, Jews made pilgrimages to the Temple in Jerusalem. It derives its name from the 'sukkah' or booth, a temporary structure in which time is spent during the holiday to commemorate God's protection of the Children of Israel during their 40 years in the wilderness.

The first two days (in Israel the first day) are full holidays. The following five intermediate days, 'Hol Hamoed,' (six in Israel) are partial holidays.

Sukkot is also a harvest festival since it is the time of the ingathering of crops in Isra-

el. During the entire Sukkot festival, the Four Species (citron, myrtle, palm, and willow) are waved during portions of the service.

This bulletin concentrates on praying for the church of the city and for the establishment of a firewall of God's presence and protection across the Gold Coast.

In the previous prayer points bulletin (June / July) other topics are set out that continue to need cover. (Domestic Violence, Family and Marriages, Business etc.) This will be left on our GC House of Prayer website –

Different people across the city will have different prayer burdens. Listen for the Holy Spirit and pray into the areas He places upon you.

Our Father, Lord of heaven and earth, May Your name be honoured in our city -

Your Kingdom come - Your will be done in our hearts and lives, in our congregations and on the Gold Coast, as it is in heaven.

### PREPARING THE GC FOR HARVEST AND KINGDOM TRANSFORMATION

Prayer walk around your neighbourhood with other believers to establish a firewall of God's presence and protection.

Church leaders and intercessors should link arms in this process to demonstrate unity within the body of Christ and Kingdom authority as a priesthood of believers. Know that the presence of Christ within you has great power to displace the enemy's schemes!

Declare your home and community to be a dwelling place for God's Presence.

"And I myself will be a wall of fire around it," declares the Lord, 'and I will be its glory within" (Zechariah 2:5).

- Celebrate the light of His presence, which brings strength & favour (Ps 89:15-17).
- Praise Him for His Presence, which disarms the enemy (Ps.31:20; Exod. 33:14).
- Thank God for His Presence which prevents any deception or falsehood from taking hold (Psalm 101:7).
- Invite the fear of the Lord to rest upon your community



(Ps.34:7; Isaiah 8:13-14).

## Call for unity in the church and oneness of spirit among spiritual leaders.

"Holy Father, protect them by the power of your name, the name you gave me, so that they may be one as we are one" (John 17:11).

- Pray that the hearts of leaders would be drawn together by a oneness of spirit (Ephesians 4:16; Galatians 3:26-28).
- Pray that a unified voice would arise from the city, reflecting the Father's heart and will (Romans 15:5-6; 2 Chronicles 30:12; 1 Corinthians 1:10).
- Pray that believers would be drawn together in the power of covenant community (Acts 18:9-10).

## Disarm any plans of the enemy to cause harm or injury to people or property.

"Do not be afraid or discouraged because of this vast army. For the battle is not yours, but God's" (2 Chronicles 20:15).

- Declare God's righteous boundaries around the city (Psalm 31:20; Jeremiah 5:22).
- Cancel any threats of harm or property damage.

- Pray that communications of the enemy would be confused and cancelled. (Jeremiah 20:11-12; Psalm 55:9-10)
- Counter negative words or curses spoken with the promises of God. (Psalm 109:26-31; 2 Corinthians 10:2-6).

## Declare the light of Truth will dispel any darkness and expose the lies.

"In Him was life, and that life was the light of all mankind. The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it" (John 1:4-5).

- Bless the city with an increased awareness of His presence and truth to dispel darkness (Psalm 36:9).
- Pray that those who oppose God's heart and ways would encounter Jesus (Acts 8:12-13).
- Pray that counterfeits would be exposed, bringing the fear of the Lord (Acts 19:14-17).
- Pray that every evil practice would collide with Truth and Life (Acts 8:4-8).

Speak God's blessings and protection over transportation & communication lines.

"The Lord will grant that the



enemies who rise up against you will be defeated before you.

They will come at you from one direction but flee from you in seven" (Deuteronomy 28:7).

- Pray protection over city streets and citizens young and old (Ps.121:8; Prov. 10:9).
- Bless the roadways and highways with the holiness of God (Isaiah 35:8-10).
- Declare the roadways consecrated unto the Lord to bring wandering souls back to Him (Jeremiah 50:5).

# Pray for the Word of God and message of the cross to be shared with power.

"For I will give you words and wisdom that none of your adversaries will be able to resist or contradict...Everyone will hate you because of me. But not a hair of your head will perish. Stand firm, and you will win life" (Luke 21:15, 17-19).

- Declare that the power of God's Word and anointing of the Holy Spirit would disarm the adversary (Acts 6:9-10; 2 Thessalonians 1:5-7).
- Pray for boldness to declare the truth of the gospel (Acts 4:29-31; Philippians 1:14).

- Pray that the Spirit of truth would be proclaimed and heard (John 16:13-14).
- Declare the favour of God on those who preach and teach the Word of God (Acts 17:16-17, 32).

## Lift up praise and worship over the city.

"Extol the Lord, Jerusalem; praise your God, Zion. He strengthens the bars of your gates and blesses your people within you" (Psalm 147:12-13).

- Magnify the name of Jesus above all other names (Luke 10:17; Phil 2:9-11).
- Declare His Lordship in your community and region (2 Kings 19:19; Psalm 50:23).
- Read psalms of praise to displace any voices of darkness (Pss. 33, 35, 65, & 67).

## Thank God for His delivering power in defeating all His enemies.

"You, dear children, are from God and have overcome them, because the one who is in you is greater than the one who is in the world" (1 John 4:4).

## YESHUA REMEMBRANCE SERVICE

*Leader:*<sup>31</sup> "Here, the days are coming," says Y'HoVaH, "when I will make a new Covenant with the house of Isra'el and with the house of Y'hudah. <sup>32</sup> It will not be like the covenant I made with their fathers on the day I took them by their hand and brought them out of the land of Egypt; because they, for their part violated My Covenant, even though I, for my part, was a husband to them," says Y'HoVaH. <sup>33</sup> "For this is the Covenant I will make with the house of Israel after those days," says Y'HoVaH, "I will put My Torah within them and write it on their hearts; I will be their Elohim, and they will be My people. (Yirem'yahu~*Jer 31:31-33* ~*Heb 8:8-10*
