

"Restrictions on businesses have been eased due to the great job Queenslanders have done in limiting community transmission of COVID-19. There is no longer a requirement for restricted businesses to operate under a COVID Safe Industry Plan or any of the 'industry specific' COVID Safe Checklists," according to the website.

'COVID Safe Industry Plans and industry specific checklists have now been replaced by the COVID Safe Checklist for Restricted Businesses (the Checklist).'

Hundreds of thousands of citizens

protesting from Cairns to the Gold Coast have told the Labor Party they will not tolerate any discrimination between vaccinated and nonvaccinated residents in day-to-day activities.

The Health Department has revoked restrictions on most activities after industry threatened to stonewall the government and ignore them.

'The revoked COVID Safe Industry Plans are available for businesses to refer to, should they wish to implement some, or all, of the measures in the plans. However, it should be noted that compliance with these plans is no longer mandatory,' the website reads.

It is now up to individual businesses to decide on what if any measures they will take to allow customers to enter their premises.

The website is quite ambiguous but it seems the QR Code requirements remain.

Restrictions on sports, fitness, food. Churches, racing. tourism and accommodation, health and beauty, weddings, hotels, clubs and numerous other activities have been revoked.

The Premier obviously is doing it tough by comments we have received from members of the media and other onlookers when today she opened a new multi-million dollar overpass built in a Cairns suburb.

Instead of travelling to the site some 8 km from the Cairns CBD the



Premier opted, undoubtedly on security advice to conduct the ceremony from the confines of the Convention Centre in the CBD.

She looked worried and worn out according to some of those present.

The people of Queensland who voted for the ... Labor Party communists have had enough and the Premier's days are numbered.

Revoked COVID Safe Checklists

The revoked COVID Safe Checklists are available for

COVID Safe Checklist for Restricted Businesses

All restricted businesses must operate in accordance with the COVID Safe Checklist for Restricted Businesses.

Restrictions for businesses include:

 no more than 1 person per 2m² indoors, or



- up to 100% seated venue capacity provided patrons or guests are in ticketed and allocated seating
- collection of contact tracing information using the <u>Check In</u> <u>Qld app</u>
- regular and thorough cleaning
- availability of hand washing facilities or hand sanitiser.

Note: Where the Chief Health Officer has issued updates to the public health directions, which differ from requirements outlined in published Approved COVID Safe Checklists, the relevant Direction(s) prevails to the extent of any inconsistency.

Stay up-to-date with any changes to Public Health Directions

Stage 3 (reviewed fortnightly) New Public Health and Social Measures ...

Movement and gatherings

- Up to 100 people can gather in homes. No limit for people gathering in public spaces.
- Indoor funerals and wedding ceremonies: One person per 2m² or 200 people or 100% allocated seated and ticketed capacity (whichever is the greater).
- **Indoor premises**: One person per 2m² or 100% allocated seated and ticketed capacity (e.g. restaurants, cafés, pubs, clubs, museums, art galleries,

- places of worship and convention centres) with the COVID Safe Checklist.
- Eating or drinking while standing allowed.
- One person per 2m² for short-term accommodation (including hostels, B&Bs and short-term rentals) with the <u>COVID Safe Checklist</u>. Density requirements do not apply in sleeping areas.
- One person per 2m² at indoor play areas with the COVID Safe Checklist.
- **Self-service food**: No restrictions.

Stadiums and indoor and outdoor events

- 100% allocated seated and ticketed for stadiums
- 100% allocated seated and ticketed capacity for indoor events or 1 person per 2m² indoors.
- No restrictions on outdoor events.
- **Ticketed venues**: 100% capacity with allocated seating (e.g. theatre, live music, cinemas, indoor sports, universities and other higher education institutions).
- Dancing: can occur anywhere at any venue (indoor and outdoor), subject to the one person per 2m² rule.
- Community sport: No restrictions.
