UN Says 'Palestine' Will Join ICC on April 1

The Palestinian Authority (PA) will join the International Criminal Court (ICC) on April 1, United Nations (UN) Secretary-General Ban Ki-moon said on Tuesday night.

In a statement posted on the UN's treaty website, the secretary-general said "the statute will enter into force for the State of Palestine on April 1, 2015." He said he was acting as the "depository" for the documents of ratification.

The PA has stated intent to file charges of war crimes against Israel in the Hague, but Israel has already filed counter-suits.

In a recent interview, the PA's envoy to the United Nations Human Rights Council (UNHRC) admitted the PA has no hope of pressing charges against Israel in international courts - because Palestinian Arab terrorist groups are far worse violators of international law themselves.

US: 'Palestine' Not a State, So Not Eligible to Join ICC

The Palestinian Authority is not eligible to join the International Criminal Court, a senior US official said Wednesday after the UN accepted a Palestinian request to adhere to the tribunal.

"The United States does not believe that the state of Palestine qualifies as a sovereign state and does not recognize it as such and does not believe that it is eligible to accede to the Rome statute" under which the ICC was set up, said State Department spokeswoman Jen Psaki.

She also stressed that the US administration would comply with the law on funding the Palestinians, amid new moves in Congress to freeze about \$440 million in annual aid if the Palestinian Authority seeks to join the court.

Psaki said the administration was in close consultations with Congress, and State Department lawyers were still looking at the implications of existing legislation.

Under the US budget for fiscal year 2015 passed in late December, aid to the Palestinians would be cut off if it tries to haul Israel before the court on war crimes charges following the 50-day war in Gaza.

Similarly, **Washington - the PA's largest donor** - said it is "reviewing" its \$440 million aid package to the PA over the move. Technically, however, only if the PA actually files war crimes charges against Israel would it be open to such a penalty under American law.

Israel Passes Japan Alliance Plan, Asian Coalition Takes Shape

A roadmap plan to radically strengthen economic ties with Japan introduced by Prime Minister Binyamin Netanyahu was approved by the Cabinet on Sunday, and paves the way for a strategic array of alliances with



three Asian superpowers - Japan, China and India.

"The State of Israel must vary the markets in which we are active. In the last two years, I have met with the leaders of China, Japan and India as part of a comprehensive policy of turning to major markets including Latin America and Africa," explained Netanyahu.

The plan involves numerous government ministries and an investment of dozens of millions of shekels over three years. It capitalizes on ties advanced last year in Netanyahu's May visit to Japan, the signing of an Industrial R&D Agreement in July - the first such agreement Japan has signed, a visit last October by Japan's Deputy Foreign Minister, and an official Israeli delegation visit to Japan last November.

As noted by Netanyahu, Israel has also increasingly been turning to India as a major military ally which in turn is shifting to give stronger diplomatic support as well. Israel has also been growing closer to China, with the two expected to hold Free Trade Agreement (FTA) talks in 2015 after signing a landmark agreement to push economic ties last May.

Particularly as ties with Europe cool amid a wide-spread move to recognize the Palestinian Authority (PA) as a state and threaten sanctions, and as the US continues to show antagonism even reaching the point of reports of American sanction threats, there appears to be a growing desire for stable alliances with economic superpowers in Asia.

The plan approved on Sunday will call on a full range of Israeli ministries to actively strengthen ties with Japan.

The Economy Ministry is to open a trade office in Osaka in addition to the existing one in Tokyo, and likewise increase the number of commercial attaches in Tokyo to strengthen Israeli business activity in Japan. It also is to expand the India-China Fund to include Japan.

Capitalizing on the world-leading technology both Japan and Israel offer, the Science, Technology and Space Ministry is to increase joint research grants by 50% in 2015, growing ties between researchers with a particular focus on space cooperation.

The Foreign Ministry is to carry out plans to have 500 young Japanese leaders visit Israel over the course of three years, having them visit for around a week while being introduced to Israel's economy, culture, administration and general life in the country.

The Transportation Ministry is also to get in on the act, advancing cooperation on various transportation technologies and infrastructures with a focus on research and development; likewise the ministries of Health, Agriculture and Rural Development, Culture and Sports are all to get involved in bilateral cooperation, and additionally there is to be cooperation regarding alternative fuels.

Following the decision on Sunday to implement the plan, a follow-up team led by the Foreign Ministry Director General will be formed to ensure the smooth advancement of the plan.

A government statement issued with the Sunday decision notes that there is a demand in Japan for Israeli-made technology in various fields such as pharmacology and medical equipment, cyber and information security, agricultural technology, and green energy and the motor vehicle market.



Middle East Officials Question "Convenient Mistakes" of US Airdrops To Al-Qaeda

As the “convenient” and “accidental” airdrops of weapons and supplies by the US and NATO into the hands of ISIS and al-Qaeda jihadists fighting inside both Syria and Iraq begin to draw more attention throughout largely alternative media outlets, such convenient mistakes are also being questioned by national governments, particularly those who may be in the crosshairs of NATO in the very near future.

Individuals who have come to question the nature of the allegedly accidental air drops are legion, but one of the more recent and high profile skeptics is the Commander of Iran’s Basij Force, Brigadier General Mohammed Reza Naqdi.

In an address to a group of Basij forces on January 5, Naqdi stated that “The US directly supports the ISIL in Iraq and the US planes drop the needed aids and weapons for ISIL in Iraq ...” In addition, he stated that the US Embassy in Baghdad is the command center for ISIL and other “takfiri” militants.

Indeed, while the United States military portrays the receipt of weapons and supplies by ISIS as entirely accidental, Naqdi presents the situation as quite the opposite. Contradicting the propaganda and stated aims of the US military, Naqdi stated that the Iraqi forces have managed to retrieve aid that was actually intended for ISIS fighters, not the other way around.

Naqdi, however, is merely the latest official in the region who has suggested that the U.S. “assault” on ISIS is half-hearted at best. Iraqi Member of Parliament Majid al-Gharawi recently stated that all information available “pointed out that US planes are supplying ISIL organization, not only in Salahuddin province, but also other provinces,” according to Iraq TradeLink.

He also stated that the United States is “not serious in fighting against the ISIL organization, because they have the technological power to determine the presence of ISIL gunmen and destroy them in one month [but have not done so].”

Gharawi suggested that the “the US is trying to expand the time of the war against the ISIL to get guarantees from the Iraqi government to have its bases in Mosul and Anbar provinces.”

It is important to mention that, according to FARS News, the Iraqi Parliamentary Security and Defense Commission revealed that a US plane did indeed supply ISIS with arms and ammunition in the Salahuddin province in Iraq, yet that revelation has received little to no coverage in the West.

In late December, 2014, yet another Iraqi lawmaker, Nahlah al-Hababi, questioned the motives and commitment of the US and its anti-ISIL coalition and claimed that the terrorist groups are actually receiving a large amount of aid dropped by unidentified aircraft.

Hababi is quoted by FARS News Agency as stating “The international coalition is not serious about air strikes on ISIL terrorists and is even seeking to take out the popular Basij (voluntary) forces from the battlefield against the Takfiris so that the problem with ISIL remains unsolved in the near future.”



She also was quoted as saying that “The ISIL terrorists are still receiving aids from unidentified fighter jets in Iraq and Syria.”

FARS also quotes Hababi as pointing out that the airstrikes launched by NATO are only launched in areas where Kurdish Peshmerga forces are fighting, while such strikes launched in other areas are “not so precise.” The suggestion, of course, is that the “coalition” has a vested interest in supporting the Kurdish forces while, at the same time, supporting ISIS in the process of weakening Syria’s Assad, Iraqi nationalism, and presumably, Iranian influence. Clearly, Hababi is not far off from the reality of the situation.

The question of such “convenient accidents” are by no means unique to the Middle Eastern, Iraqi, or Iranian press reports, however. These types of “mistakes” happen on a seemingly regular basis in areas where the United States is allegedly fighting the very terrorist organization it created. In October, 2014, “coalition” forces dropped a number of aid supplies and ammunition allegedly intended for the Iraqi people and anti-ISIS forces on the ground into territory controlled by ISIS. The “mistake” was confirmed by Iraqi officials and parliamentarians.

Only in the West, it seems, does the general public look upon the so-called mistakes as anything but a sloppy excuse to re-arm NATO’s terrorist mercenaries in order to reinvigorate their proxy war.

As FARS writes,

In late December, the US-led coalition dropped aids to the Takfiri militants in an area North of Baghdad. Field sources in Iraq told al-Manar that the international coalition airplanes dropped aids to the terrorist militants in Balad, an area which lies in Salahuddin province North of Baghdad.

In October, a high-ranking Iranian commander also slammed the US for providing aid supplies to ISIL, adding that the US claims that the weapons were mistakenly airdropped to ISIL were untrue.

“The US and the so-called anti-ISIL coalition claim that they have launched a campaign against this terrorist and criminal group – while supplying them with weapons, food and medicine in Jalawla region (a town in Diyala Governorate, Iraq). This explicitly displays the falsity of the coalition’s and the US’ claims,” Deputy Chief of Staff of the Iranian Armed Forces Brigadier General Massoud Jazayeri said.

The US claimed that it had airdropped weapons and medical aid to Kurdish fighters confronting the ISIL in Kobani, near the Turkish border in Northern Syria.

The US Defense Department said that it had airdropped 28 bundles of weapons and supplies, but one of them did not make it into the hands of the Kurdish fighters.

Video footage later showed that some of the weapons that the US airdropped were taken by ISIL militants.
