Central Elections Committee Votes to Ban MK Hanin Zoabi

The Central Elections Committee Thursday voted 27-6 to ban extremist Arab MK Hanin Zoabi (Balad) from running in the upcoming general elections.

Earlier, the committee meeting was the scene of loud shouting on Thursday, as Zoabi appeared to defend herself over the petition to ban her from running for the Knesset in the current election campaign.

The petition was submitted by Yisrael Beytenu head Avigdor Liberman and Otzma Yehudit/Yachad - Ha'am Itanu candidate Baruch Marzel, over anti-Israel remarks and actions she has made over the years.

Speaking at the Committee hearing, Zoabi said that she was not the one that should be put "on trial. The occupation is the source of all violence, and for those who did not notice, the two people who filed this petition are the ones who have turned my entire nation into terrorists." She and that "nation," said Zoabi, "are part of the Palestinian nation. We are Palestinians."

The comments elicited a great deal of shouting and catcalling, with MKs telling Zoabi that she did not represent the Arab public, and that she condoned, and even praised, terror attacks against Israelis and Jews. "Is there an 'occupation' in Paris? Is there occupation in ISIS-held lands?" shouted MKs at Zoabi, referring to the recent murder of four Jews in the Hyper Cacher market in Paris, and the beheading of Western hostages by ISIS terrorists.

Zoabi also provoked anger after smirking and laughing during her speech, and was interrupted repeatedly by Ha'am Itanu party leader Eli Yishai who called her a "terrorist."

In the petition, Marzel - who is himself facing attempts to ban him - and Liberman included choice samples of the anti-Israel and pro-terror comments made over the years by several of the candidates, including MK Hanan Zoabi. In an interview with Russian media, for example, Zoabi said "I have no problem with Iran, and I am very supportive of all the groups fighting the occupation of the Palestinians by Israel. I certainly support any and all groups fighting the occupation."

The petition noted that several candidates, primarily Zoabi, have given vocal support to terrorists such as Hamas in their efforts to destroy Israel, and promote "the armed struggle of Israel's enemies and terror groups against Israel, which according to the Basic Law: Knesset prevents then from running in an election."

"I am going to wipe the smirk off Hanin Zoabi's face," Marzel said when he filed the petition several weeks ago. "She advocates the killing of IDF soldiers, and the murders of children."

If advocating murder was the criteria for being termed a terrorist, said Zoabi, it was the petitioners who deserved that title, claiming that Israel's defensive actions against Hamas terrorists in Gaza was somehow the equivalent of "murder."



"Those who do not condemn the murder of hundreds of children in Gaza are supporters of terror," she said. "What bothers those who seek to ban me from running is the fact that I am a Palestinian and want to continue being a Palestinian, even in the Knesset."

Syrian army tears through the south to sweep Iran and Hizballah up to Israel's Golan doorstep

The Syrian army's Ninth Division and 121st Brigade armed with 50 T-72 tanks led a sweeping Iranian-Hizballah offensive dubbed "Operation Ali Allah Dadi for Quneitra Martyrs." With them were 4,000 Shiite fighters imported by Iran for the battle and several hundred Hizballah gunmen - all under the command of Iranian Revolutionary Guards officers.

The operation started out with an Iranian-led force advancing on the southern Syrian town of Deraa - part of which is held by Syrian rebels - and heading for the junction of the Syrian-Jordanian and Israeli borders.

Strong dust and sand storms over the region this week restricts visibility and kept Syrian fighter jets grounded. Nonetheless, the Syrian-Hizballah-Iranian force, by dint of its superior numbers and fire power, were able to drive Syrian rebels out of many of the sectors they held and push them back toward the Israeli border.

By Tuesday night, ground reconnaissance had sighted the advancing force reaching a line 5-6 km south and east of Quneitra and in position to capture the Syrian Golan town.

Monday, Feb. 9, Syrian Foreign Minister Walid Muallem emphasized that Israel's efforts to create a buffer zone on the Golan, like the security enclave it maintained in South Lebanon, would not succeed.

The object of the Quneitra offensive is clearly to root out Syrian rebel forces, claimed to be backed by Israel, from the positions they hold facing the Israeli Golan. To replace them, a token Syrian contingent made up mostly of Shiite fighters trained by Iran's Revolutionary Guards. An armed Hizballah force will move in and to establish a forward position on Israel's Golan doorstep.

Lebanese Army Receives Massive US Arms Shipment

Members of the Lebanese Army were spotted unloading a massive arms shipment on Sunday supplied by the United States government.

The munitions included 70 M198 Howitzer artillery units, along with 26 million rounds of ammunition.

According to a press release by the U.S. Embassy in Beirut, the "American Ambassador David Hale presided over the delivery of \$25 million in assistance to the Lebanese Armed Forces."

"Lebanon is now the 5th largest recipient in the world of U.S. military foreign assistance. Over \$100 million last year, and over \$1 billion in the last 8 years," the statement added. "This is top of the line equipment, the best that is on the market. It is what our soldiers use, and we're proud to know that very soon, your brave soldiers will be using it too, along with other U.S.- supplied equipment, to defeat the terrorist and extremist threat from Syria."

"We are fighting the same enemy, so our support for you has been swift

and continuous," the Ambassador said from Beirut."

Some national security experts have warned that the weapons shipments may fall into the hands of terrorist groups such as Hezbollah, the Shiite Iranian proxy that occupies the country's south.

In late January, a YouTube video appeared to show a Hezbollah convoy loading American made military vehicles onto a platform. The vehicles included an M1 Abrams tank, M113 armored personnel carriers, Humvees, and Mine-Resistant Ambush Protected vehicles.

Other reports have stated that the Lebanese army and Hezbollah have attempted to combine forces in order to attack neighboring Israel.

- 17. Out of 690 General Assembly resolutions voted on before 1990, 429 were directed against Israel.
- 18. The UN was silent while the Jordanians destroyed 58 synagogues in Jerusalem.
- 19. The UN was silent while the Jordanians systematically desecrated the ancient Jewish cemetery on the Mount of Olives.
- 20. The UN was silent while the Jordanians enforced an apartheid-like policy of preventing Jews from visiting the Temple Mount and the Western Wall.
